Question

I have been looking online, but I can't find out what you think will happen following one's death. Can you direct me to where I can find that?

Answer

The brief answer is:

What happens when you die is completely dependent on what happened when you were alive in the flesh, and the decisions, choices, feelings, emotions, beliefs and loves you held onto while living on the earth (called your soul condition). In particular, what happens is very dependent on how developed in Love you are, and how much you understand the Divine Truth. Since all of these things are unique for each individual, then the actual events after you die will be very personal and unique.

I am currently presenting a series of talks about what happens when you die, and life in the different dimensions of the spirit world.
