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Title	Jesus – Does AJ hold to the teachings contained within the Bible Gospel accounts?

Question

Considering that you are Jesus, does that mean that you agree and hold to the teachings of Jesus as left with us as found in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John?

Answer

I am sorry to say that, although I am Jesus, I cannot agree and hold to ALL of the teachings that are claimed to be my teachings from the first century as contained within the Bible gospel accounts of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.

Since I was present in the 1st century and remember my life then, and the events that are meant to be recorded in the Bible surround what everyone supposed happened to me, I can state categorically that I did not teach all of the teachings the Bible claims I taught, and I did not make all of the statements the Bible claims I made. Also, some of the events the Bible claims happened did not happen, while other events that did happen have not been recorded. In addition, there are a great many things I did teach and state that are not contained within the Gospel accounts.

There is some Truth in the Gospel accounts, both about my life and my teachings, but, unfortunately, there is also quite a lot of misrepresentation, misunderstanding, purposeful deceit, and error contained within those same accounts. Unfortunately, at the time of my death, even many of my disciples still did not clearly understand what I was teaching them, and they often held onto their own error based opinions, and they had clear disagreements with me about what I was teaching. Some still harboured a large amount of violent rage towards authority, they treated women, including my own wife, very badly, and still did not understand either love itself, nor how the Love of God enters the human soul.

Because of these various factors, the Bible record unfortunately contains many contradictions about my presentation of Divine Truth, the Truth about God, to the Israelite nation, and I was not a person given to making contradictory statements, particularly about God and God's Nature and Character. Also, there are many essential things about my life that are not contained within the Bible, and that have been purposely misrepresented, not by the original writers, but by the revisionists. Many of these revisionists did not have loving nor pure intentions, and they had personal agendas for the manipulation of facts to suit themselves.

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Unfortunately, the records some of my friends made from their own memory of those events years after my death were highly distorted due to 250 years of copying by hand by the time that Emperor Constantine, who was a very violent man, attempted to construct through the First Council of Nicaea in 325AD, with the help of many men who were yet to understand Love and who were often quite violent themselves, a "standard" record of my life. They constructed the first uniform so-called Christian belief system, which, unfortunately was not an accurate rendition of my teachings. Any bishop who refused to endorse the creed was exiled. Anyone who disagreed with the creed was generally executed.

Thus began the erosion of the Biblical Cannon, something that began in support of the Nicaean Council's edicts, and proceeded over many centuries of time. But, by the time of the Councils of Carthage in 397AD, there was general support for the Bible cannon as proposed by the Bibles that were produced during the time of Constantine.

Unfortunately, during this erosion, many Truths were removed from the original records, since they did not agree with the temporal power that Constantine and subsequent rulers wanted to hold by creating and enforcing the Holy Roman Empire, which was an amalgamation of religious and political power, and many untruths were added so they could be used as a weapon to control people. Religion became the weapon of power, rather than the "religion" of the personal soul relationship with God that I taught. Further "church" revisionists changed the record after that time, and many beliefs that are now accepted as Christian beliefs were first presented by those who controlled the empire, rather than being an accurate statement of my own teachings.

The oldest surviving "New Testament" manuscripts are from the 4th century; a time after many of these Councils had already determined their own interpretation of the words as Truth. Earlier manuscripts do not exist to compare with. A definitive list of the Bible books did not come from an Ecumenical Council until the Council of Trent (1545–63AD). Although it is not really known when the first Biblical Cannon was assembled, Pope Damasus I assembled a list of books of the Bible at the Council of Rome in 382AD. He then commissioned Jerome to produce a reliable and consistent text by translating the original Greek and Hebrew texts into Latin. Books that contained challenging information, or information different to the declared Truth, were not included in this Cannon. This translation became known as the Latin Vulgate Bible and in 1546 at the Council of Trent was declared by the Church to be the only authentic and official Bible in the Latin Rite. The vast majority of manuscripts date after the 10th century, so, again, there is nothing to compare to.

The reality also is that what is now known as the Old Testament had a large impact on my life in the 1st century, and I discovered a lot about God's Love through the prophetic books and the Psalms. I did not, however, believe those writings to be written by God, or inspired of God, since I knew that many of the writers had connected to the spirits of people who had lived in earlier times, and that is how they received a lot of their information.

As for yourself, while you may not wish to believe what I have stated above, and perhaps wish to hold onto the Bible as being the "Word of God" in every detail, I can assure you that what I speak is the Truth, and that, when you pass over from this life into the spirit world, you will be able to validate what I have said if you so wish. There are very many Christians who wish to hold onto and maintain that the Bible contains a complete, accurate and inspired record about God, Jesus and other Truths, but I can assure you that it does not.

Almost all of these Christians when they die realize that the Truth has been misrepresented to them. However, when they come to terms emotionally with the lie that has been perpetrated against them, they also realize that God, and God's Universe, is far grander and more loving than anything they had been able to personally conceive, and many of the writings of the Bible

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that do contain Truth begin to take on a far deeper meaning than they had previously imagined possible.

If you do not believe what I say to be true, then my suggestion is to take care about being dogmatic about it, since an open mind and heart is far more responsive to Truth and Love than a heart that is constrained by dogmatism.

My assurances of these facts are based around my personal experience, because like you can remember your life, I remember my own life and what happened to me, and I know which events the Bible records that actually happened, and also those events that are recorded in the Bible that did not happen, because I am in the position where 4 of the books of the Bible actually relate to my own personal life experience.

I know the Truth about my own life far better than anyone else does, aside from God, just as, I put to you, you know the Truth about what has happened in your own life!

Many Christians currently attack me, stating that since I have not returned in the manner that is described supposedly by myself in the Bible, that I cannot be the person I claim to be. But this is, unfortunately, a long stretch of logic, since it assumes that a written record first penned nearly 2,000 years ago years after my own death is firstly an accurate record of my life. Secondly, that written record is no longer available in its original form for evidential purposes, and so the assumption that the copies that have been made are accurate is also a long stretch of logic.

Also, the assumption that the record has retained its original purity by some "act of God" is flawed. I warned my disciples that the "the enemy would come and over sow the wheat with weeds." I warned that the field would be infiltrated with the errors of the wicked ones. Many Christians today believe that this over sowing has not occurred in regards to their own religion and Bible, but this is in direct disharmony with my own warnings. For these and many other reasons, it is not advisable for any Christian who wishes to become closer to God to trust that the Bible has remained without error.

Shortly I will be doing presentations about the Bible, and the manner in which it portrays God, myself and my life, the disciples, and my teachings, and I will offer many corrections that will be worth considering for any person who is sincere about growing in Love, and growing closer to God and becoming at-one with our Creator.

I hope for the moment, my answer satisfies your question until I can reply in more detail through the presentations I do.
