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Answer

Well, it depends on the degree of the flaw doesn't it. I feel that the Bible is seriously flawed in its discussion of God. It really portrays God terribly. It portrays God almost like a megalomaniac person on Earth, a person who is a dictator, and God's not like this at all. I feel that's its primary flaw. The problem is that if you believe in a God like that you finish up becoming like that yourself, and that's not a good thing either. Whatever you believe in you often finish up becoming and so if you believe in a God that's a dictator and a megalomaniac – and God's not like that – who wants power and wants the worship of everybody, if you believe in a God like that then eventually you start enforcing the opinions of that kind of God. That's why there have been a lot of Christian-based wars on this planet, as a result of those particular opinions.

Also, what the Bible says about the human soul isn't accurate at all. There are some parts of it that are accurate when it comes to the human soul but a lot of it is not accurate.

What the Bible states about what is proper behaviour between people: Some of that is accurate and some of that is not.

How the Bible views women: a very inaccurate viewpoint of women and therefore a very inaccurate viewpoint of the soul. The equality of the sexes is something that's not well presented in the Bible and is in fact disagreed with in the Bible and therefore out of harmony with Truth and out of harmony with God. Yeah, there are so many issues you could list where there are major flaws.

Mary: What about issues of sexuality and homosexuality? Would you say ...

Well, these are areas where there are some flaws and there are also some truths. The Bible does contain areas where there are some flaws and some truths. On the issue of sexuality, obviously having moral behaviour between partners, between men and women, between men and men, and women and women, is part of the truth. However the whole concept that homosexuality is condemned by God is completely false. Some of my best friends in the spirit world are homosexual in nature in the sense that their soulmate is the same gender, and was the same gender on Earth, as they are. The apostle John is one of those persons. The whole concept of homosexuality is completely in error and as people grow in love they start to realise that it is completely in error. A lot of people justify it through the natural use of a woman and the natural use of a man and all these other justifications but they are all just justifications written in a book and as a person grows in love and grows towards God they start realising that these justifications have no basis in truth and no basis in love either. So the Bible is severely flawed in some areas of morality, quite true.

Mary: What about historical issues or issues about your life?

Again, it's sort of like the middle of the road there as well. There are some areas that it mentions that are completely true historically, that are fairly accurate. Some of the memories of the people as they wrote things down are fairly accurate as well. There are other things that are completely false. You know there are things about my life in the first century that are completely false. It portrays me as having a mother who never had sex before I was born, not true. My mother told me she had sex before I was born; my mother and father had sex and as a result I was conceived. So there was no virgin birth for example.

Mary: Were they married when that ...

Yes, they were married. My father looked for a good wife and found one. And they fell in love. My father and mother at the beginning of their relationship were very much in love. They are very much in love now as well because they happen to also be soulmates. But there was a period of time in my life in the first century where they weren't very much in love at all and in fact they would admit it, that they weren't very much in love at all. That was generally because of the way they treated each other and particularly my father towards my mother at times. This was the common way that men in the first century treated their women, which was also flawed. There are so many things about my life that we can mention. Perhaps one thing we need to do is just list the different things eventually as a question and answer series and say, "Yes, no, yes, no," and just answer the questions directly as to what was true and what was not true.

Mary: What about just speaking in generalities about what is inaccurate in the Bible? What about issues of heaven and hell and what happens when we die?

Well, the Bible contains contradictions about heaven and hell and what happens when you die. For example in the Old Testament there are scriptures that say when you die you are dead and nothing, you are completely non-existent. This is an obvious error but

it's contained within the Bible. Most people who read their Bible are not even aware that it says so, in the Book of Proverbs and Ecclesiastes for example. As a result of that most people just ignore those passages as if they've never read them. The Bible also states, particularly with my teachings, some of which are recorded in the Bible relatively accurately, that there is an afterlife where people can talk to each other and see each other. While many people interpret that as a metaphor, I also said quite clearly that it wasn't just a metaphor but that this was a possibility in the spirit world, that you could speak with other people. And you could speak with other people on Earth, and I demonstrated that through my day-to-day life by talking to people who were spirit-influenced; I spoke to the spirits through the people.

So there are many truths that are contained there if you look at it but unfortunately most people have a very fixed concept when they look at those particular things. It's almost like they are told a heap of things about the Bible before they read it, and then they are told what they can believe from the Bible when they read it, and they are told how to interpret it when they read it. If you had not been told any of those things and you read the Bible with a completely open mind and heart you would be shocked at what you have accepted as real and what is not actually real, when you read the Bible. I feel that most people would be absolutely shocked, and will be shocked in the future about what they actually accepted as real when logic and also love would dictate that such a thing was not possible.
