Response

The report given in the Channel 7 "Today Tonight" TV program hosted by Rodney Lohse is almost entirely false in their claims about Mary and I.

The reporter for Channel 7, David Millikan, and his cameraman came to stay at our home for two nights free of charge in March 2011, and spent many other days with us. Channel 7 requested that I do not talk to Channel 9 until they aired their own program "Sunday Night", which was eventually shown in September 2011 (comments are also on this website). However I could not agree to this. So when Channel 9 came to interview us for a report in "A Current Affair" in May 2011, Channel 7 decided to make a hastily prepared program from the material that they had collected in March 2011 for this report in "Today Tonight".

During the time that David Millikan and his cameraman stayed at our home we cooked and cleaned for them, gave them unrestricted access to our property, and demonstrated complete openness and honesty in dealing with them. We stated that we would not take legal action against Channel 7 if they purposefully lied about us and misrepresented us, a promise that Mr Millikan has taken full advantage of, since most of their claims were completely false and defamatory, and could be shown to be so from our own recordings of our interactions. We stated this because we believe that it is loving for us to give a gift of ourselves, our time and our sincerity without concern about whether others misuse the gift. How people respond to gifts is a measure of their own development in love.

The way that Channel 7 responded to the gift of our time and our hospitality has been to fabricate a series of lies about us in order to create a media "sensation", to improve their ratings and to make money. They are fully aware of the lies that they are telling but have chosen to act out of integrity for the reasons above. I actually mentioned this later in a discussion with Mr David Millikan, but he justified the report. I will address each of the points that they raised in the TV presentation and explain the falsifications that were contained within the program feature.

Accusations about me being a "cult leader"

"First tonight inside the growing Jesus cult of AJ Miller."

The only people who compare me to cult leaders are the media themselves. My seminars are open to anyone who wishes to come to listen to Divine Truth, and people are free to come and go as they please during them. I do not charge for any of the seminars that I give, since I believe that Divine Truth should always be provided for free. People who come to my seminars do not need to stay for the duration of my talks and they can leave at any time. There is no "membership" or any other binding nature of the Divine Truth. All of the material that I teach is freely available unedited on the Divine Truth website (in fact, most of the material shown by the media are from these publicly accessible recordings), as well as the Divine Truth channel on YouTube, and DVDs and external hard drives containing our material are copied and distributed for free.

So there is no secrecy in any of the material that I present, which the media wishes to suggest by using the term "cult", in order to make me appear secretive and controlling, which I am not. I have very little dealings day to day with most of the people who attend my seminars. I do not attempt to control anyone who comes to my seminars and listens to my presentations on YouTube or on DVDs. I actively encourage people who listen to my seminars to follow their own desires in harmony with Love and Truth, rather than attempt to have any kind of dependency on myself. This is vital if they are going to grow in their relationship with God. I describe this in the talk "20100412 The Human Soul - Taking Personal Responsibility".

Having any kind of control over people is also in total opposition to what I teach about God's Law of Free Will, since whenever somebody tries to control another person, they are

immediately out of harmony with the Law of Free Will, and this incurs a consequence for their soul condition, taking them further away from God. Since my main objective in life is to grow in love and to grow towards God, this is a direct contradiction of my teachings and how I live my life. These teachings are described in the talk "20120421 The Human Soul – The Gift of Free Will" and "20120422 The Human Soul – The Gift of Free Will".

"Our hidden cameras went inside his Queensland headquarters..."

This is an outright lie by Channel 7. The interviewer and cameraman were staying as guests at our home, and were invited to come and film at the seminars that I gave and at our home, which they are referring to as my "Queensland headquarters". I introduced them at the beginning of the presentation to the audience, and there are many times during the seminar that I gave that day, " 20110319 The Human Soul – Addictions & Bribery, Fear, Threats & Blackmail" (which can be viewed in full on YouTube [here](#)), that the Channel 7 cameras are in plain sight for anyone to see. They are blatantly lying about this to manipulate the public into thinking that I run some kind of secret organisation, whereas it is clear from what I have written above that this is not the case.

"AJ Miller and his partner Mary Luck call this 16 hectare property near Kingaroy in Queensland 2 hours West of Brisbane headquarters for their Divine Truth movement."

There is no Divine Truth "headquarters". Mary and I live in a very humble two bedroom house on a 40 acre property 36kms outside of Kingaroy. Channel 7 know this for the reasons I have above stated. Our home is similar to anyone else's home in the area. Nobody else lives with us although occasionally we do have short-term visitors to our home, just as most other people entertain friends in their own home from time to time. We do not even have fences around our property. We took them all down as some wildlife were getting caught in the wire. Our property is just our private home. All of the media refer to our home as the "headquarters" or the "compound", and any reasonable person who has visited our home would have to question why they do so.

"A Christian based organisation that sees AJ as its spiritual leader."

Channel 7 are making the leap that because I say that I am Jesus then I am forming a Christian based organization and implying that I am therefore creating a new religion, with me as the leader. This is an attempt by them to make it appear that I am looking for power and control over others, but neither of these things are true. I am not attempting to set up a religion, cult, religious following, sect, or any other hierarchy that other people have created. My teachings are not what Christians generally accept. I am just teaching any person who wants to listen about how to have a direct personal relationship with God without any intermediary, including myself, and without a religion. Most religions install a hierarchy of intermediaries between people and God, and I cannot agree with these actions. I believe the principles of Divine Truth can be introduced into all religions, and I do not wish to be the leader of any religion.

It is impossible for me to be an intermediary between any person and God, because the only way to form a close personal relationship with God is to do so directly, just as we cannot form a close personal relationship with any other person with a third party as an intermediary. I actively discourage people who listen to my seminars from focusing on me rather than God, and in fact find it very distasteful when people attempt to direct their worship towards me, rather than towards our true Parent and Creator, God. All of the people who know me never attempt to worship me. I also have no intention of developing a new religion because I believe there are already too many religions on the planet that are fighting with one another. We are not the

leaders of a religious sect or organization, and we have no religious structure or organization at all.

"He's ... on a national recruiting drive cutting a swathe through the suburbs."

And later on:

"The pair who bought the property in 2007 have been recruiting followers from across Australia."

Mary and I are not "on a national recruiting drive" and we do not force the teachings onto people who do not wish to hear them. We only travel to places where we have been invited by people to speak for two reasons. The first reason is because we have no desire to present a seminar to people who have no desire to listen to us. In the first century I taught to not give truth to those who do not wish to receive it, unless you are already in a personal interaction with the person, because it is harming the other person's free will (which I explain in the talk "20091114 Relationship with God – Humility"). The other reason that Mary and I only travel to places where we have been invited is because we do all of our presentations for free. Therefore we are not able to travel to a location unless the people who have invited us, or some other people who are interested in others hearing the Truth, donate the funds in order for us to travel.

Since there is no membership involved in listening to the Divine Truth, and since I have no control over the material that I produce because it is not copyrighted and is given away for free; there is no organization or structure to recruit into. I teach people who wish to listen about how to grow in love and truth. I cannot see how that is "cutting a swathe through the suburbs."

Also, I purchased our property before I met Mary in 2007. So we did not purchase the property together.

"Miller while comparing himself to Jesus has an uncanny likeness to the branch Divinian cult leader David Koresh, who died in this inferno in 1993, along with 75 of his followers in WACO, Texas."

I do not "compare" myself to Jesus. I am saying that I am Jesus, the same Jesus who was on earth in the 1st century, and who had a spirit existence before returning to earth in the 20th century.

The only people who have ever compared me to WACO are members of the media themselves. Nobody who knows me has ever made such a comparison. There is no cult or religious sect, and using this terminology is an attempt by the media to sensationalize the truth. Then they attempt to strengthen this leap by saying that I bare a strong physical resemblance to David Koresh, which I cannot see. If Channel 7 are attempting to suggest that anybody who looks similar to another person must have exactly the same beliefs, personalities, and other traits, this argument is based on no logic at all.

As far as I am aware, David Koresh had very different belief systems and teachings to what I have been teaching, and had a very different character and ideals than I do. Mr Koresh was the leader of a religious sect; I am not the leader of anything. Mr Koresh believed himself to be the final prophet for the sect; I do not believe myself to be the final prophet of anything. Mr Koresh wanted to set up a kingdom on earth; I do not wish to setup any kingdom at all, but I would like for love to be the ruling principle on earth. Mr Koresh believed in a doomsday; I do not. Mr Koresh often had firearms in his possession; I believe no person should carry firearms and I have never owned any. Mr Koresh had several sexual partners at the same time; I only have

one sexual partner, Mary, and believe in monogamy. Mr Koresh was willing to engage in violence; I do not believe violence is the solution to any problem. There is an indication that Mr Koresh believed that suicide was acceptable under certain circumstances; I believe suicide is not acceptable under any circumstances.

While they are discussing the Branch Davidians religious leader David Koresh, they take the following quote from of my DVDs out of context, suggesting that I am manipulating people into thinking that if they follow me then their souls will be rewarded, an approach that cult leaders have used in the past:

"AJ: It's sort of like a crown of glory for your own soul." (Clip from a DVD)

In context, I was speaking about how being loving to other people creates rewards for your own soul. I was not stating that a person following me, or being a member of a religious movement that does not actually exist, is like a crown of glory for your own soul. I was speaking about the effects of acting in harmony with love.

The only way that people can improve their soul condition to a condition of at-onement with God is by practicing the "Way" to God (described in the talk "20111218 Relationship with God – The Way"), which is a personal journey that people need to go through with God. It has nothing to do with me, other than the fact that I am telling them how to go about it. I learnt this when I became at-one with God in the first century.

"Rick Ross is a cult expert and specialises in bringing those who fall victim to self proclaimed prophets out of their vice like grip."

Rick Ross: Ultimately that's a device to exploit them and take advantage of them in my opinion."

Channel 7 have clearly approached Rick Ross for his views on cults, and while they may be accurate of some organizations or people, Rick Ross has no understanding or knowledge of the Divine Truth that I teach, and his statements about my teachings and me bear no resemblance to who I am or what I am teaching. I have never met him and he is making assumptions about me that are not based on any actual truth. He has clearly not even investigated my teachings. If he did, he would likely agree with many of them.

I do not wish to have any control over the lives of people who listen to my teachings, and certainly don't have a "vice like grip" over the people who listen to me, since outside of my seminars I see very little of vast majority of the people who listen to me. People around me do whatever they wish, and I do not normally provide guidance to them unless they personally ask and I personally have the time to do so.

Rick Ross is suggesting that the people who listen to me are not capable of making up their own minds and in doing so is being very condescending to many very intelligent people. Many of the people who come to my seminars are very well educated people who are highly able in the area of critical thinking. I fail to see how delivering information for free to whomever wishes to listen is exploiting or taking advantage of people. I encourage everybody who attends my seminars to discover truth for themselves, and not to take my or the media's word for it. I teach that to discover truth we need to learn it emotionally, rather than intellectually, and this involves a process of releasing our emotional errors first before we can receive God's Truth on any matter. I teach that we must learn to experiment with what may be "truth", and make mistakes, before we can discover the actual truth. In fact I regularly stress in my seminars that knowing the

Truth intellectually is completely ineffective at changing our lives, because we have to learn the truth in our hearts before we change our lives and become more loving.

I also do not call myself a prophet, and do not believe myself to be in condition to make accurate prophecies about the future, and I have stated this publicly many times. Anybody who states I am making firm prophecies about the future has not listened to my many comments about my own personal condition and abilities.

"Rick Ross: I think that in a group like Miller's there's this feeling like I am in a personal relationship with God."

Since Rick Ross has never met me, or had any dealings with the Divine Truth, he is not in a position to make any comments about "a group like Miller's". First of all it is not "my group" – I merely speak to those who wish to listen to me, and I do not have a group. Secondly he knows nothing about the people who listen to the Divine Truth, and so he's making a claim about people based on no foundation whatsoever, putting words into the mouths of people he has never met. The media obtain the services of a person such as Rick Ross, and then use their comments as a basis for a so-called "expert" opinion. This is both manipulative and disingenuous (to use a word from Mr Millikan's own vocabulary).

If people implement Divine Truth teachings in their lives then they will establish a personal relationship with God. The Divine Truth teaches God's Way to connect to God, rather than man's way to connect to God, and it is the only true way to form a close personal relationship with God to reach the point of at-onement.

"In Australia AJ and Mary's followers learn about their soul and its previous incarnations and they're taught how to remember them."

This is a complete fabrication. Only two people who come to my seminars presently believe themselves to be reincarnated, but I did not convince them of this. Every other person who attends my seminars regularly is in their first incarnation, even if they do not personally believe it. I do not teach those people, or the two who were reincarnated, to remember their previous lives, since I believe almost all people who I meet have not had a previous life. My teachings about reincarnation are very confronting to those who actually believe in the current eastern philosophies of reincarnation.

I teach people how to open up their souls through an emotional process, and how to connect to God emotionally. During this process of exploring our souls suppressed memories often re-surface, because they can be suppressed by negative emotions that we do not want to experience. For most people those memories are from their childhoods, but for the two reincarnated people the memories are from their lives in the first century and their lives in the spirit world as well as this life.

I do not teach people generally that they have had "previous incarnations"; this is another misunderstanding and misrepresentation of the material I teach. I also do not believe people can remember previous incarnations when everyone on the planet other than the 14 who have returned have never had a previous incarnation on this earth.

Accusations about me being part of God

"He claims he's the son of God re-born."

And later on:

"He's the self proclaimed son of God..."

I definitely do claim I am a son of God, just as I also claim that every person on earth and every person who has ever lived is either a son or daughter of God. The media are trying to suggest that I am stating that I am special and other people are ordinary, when the reality is that I believe that everyone is special, and a child of God.

Channel 7 and David Millikan are also well aware that I do not set myself up as God, as we discussed this issue at length. They make these statements in a bid to persuade the public that this is my claim. The media are making the assertion that because I say that I am Jesus then I am saying that I am God, or the only son of God, but this is based on falsities that are taught by the Bible, and in Mr Millikan's own so-called Christian belief systems. I am a son of God, just as every human on Earth is a son or daughter of God. I am not part of God, although in the first century I did become Divine in nature, when I become at-one with God. Since then many people have reached this condition in the spirit world, but they also do not claim to be God. So I see myself as a brother and equal to all other humans on Earth and in the spirit world.

The issue of my identity

"He claims he's the son of God re-born, and his partner is Mary Magdalene reincarnated. And they're finding plenty of followers who believe them."

The media are also making the assumption that most of the people who listen to me believe that I am Jesus, when in fact at the moment very few of them actually do. The media has made this statement in order to create an impression that I have brainwashed the people who come to listen to my talks, when I have not. The people who attend my seminars are generally from all walks of life, who are highly able to decide for themselves whether I am teaching the truth or not. They come to listen to me are drawn to the Divine Truth that I teach because they can feel the truth resonate inside of themselves and they can see how effective the teachings are at changing their lives for the better.

After watching the material, many people do have an initial feeling that I am Jesus. However, over a period of time, that feeling usually diminishes and is replaced by doubt, because it is very difficult for an individual person to accept everything I state in my seminars without there being some resistance and disbelief.

Accusations about me breaking up families

"Our hidden cameras went inside his Queensland headquarters to find the cult is busting up families..."

This is another complete fabrication by Channel 7. Firstly, as I previously mentioned, there is no Queensland headquarters. Channel 7 spent time in my private home and they are fully aware that this home is not any headquarters of some world wide movement. It is our personal home, and we work from home.

Secondly, there were no hidden cameras. I do not know why Channel 7 wish to claim that their cameras were hidden, when they were in full view to ever person who came to our home, and were in full view of every attendee in the audience of the seminar we attended. This is a

complete lie, seemingly to create the impression for the audience that there was some secret investigation that was done by Channel 7 into a secretive cult (a cult that does not exist). We have photographs and videos of their so-called "hidden" cameras. Maybe it was just an effort of one-up-man-ship with Channel 9.

Thirdly, I encourage people to treat everyone lovingly, including their families. Most people who listen to my teachings are still in the same relationships that they were in when they met me. There are some people who listen to my teachings who have left their relationships, but they have done so on their own accord, not due to any direct consultation that I have had with them. In fact, it is rare for me to counsel people about their personal relationships, especially when both parties are not present. I do not teach people to leave their marriages, but I do help people to examine within themselves what is going on emotionally for themselves, and within their marriage. On some occasions this causes people to re-evaluate whether they would like to stay in the marriage that they are in, and to examine whether their marriage is still based on love.

I believe that when people practice my teachings their relationships with others become more real (in that each person will be much more honest with each other than before), and therefore more loving. Of course, this sometimes results in friction, because people are not used to hearing the full truth from each other. Many people, once hearing the teachings, confess things that they have done to their partners or families that the family was unaware of. This will, of course, mean that the family will face some emotions to feel as a result of them now knowing the truth. My teachings encourage others to only be truthful with each other in a loving manner. This means you would be loving to yourself as well as the other person, and it will not be what the world defines as love.

However, I do find it interesting that Mr Millikan, who interviewed us, is an ordained minister of a Christian religion who accepts as its leader someone who is supposed to have said, as recorded in the Bible in Matthew 10:34-36; "Do not suppose that I have come to bring peace to the Earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. For I have come to turn a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law— a man's enemies will be the members of his own household." (New International Version).

I find it outstanding hypocrisy that the same man who claims that I am destroying families, and condemns me for actions I have never taken, also claims to worship a man whom he claims to be God, and whom he believes said the above words. Apparently the Jesus of the Bible is allowed to destroy families, but the modern day Jesus needs to be condemned for the same supposed behaviour. I am sure that someone in the future will claim I cannot be Jesus because I am not destroying families! Mr Millikan's position is two-faced and deceitful, and taken just to inflame the public and manipulate them while he himself has a different set of beliefs, which we have discussed. I actually mentioned this to him in the recorded interview, but of course, that piece of information was mostly left on the editing room floor.

Channel 7 then go on to claim that I am responsible for some personal problems within the life of the actor Kym Valentine:

"She's the Australian actress who's been cut off from her own daughter. (Clip shown of Neighbours) Lost to a divisive cult and its leader AJ Miller."

"It's understood one of his followers here in Australia is the former husband of neighbours actor, Kym Valentine."

Craig Bennett: The industry insiders are saying Kym's big concern is that her ex husband is trying to sweep their beloved daughter into the Jesus cult.

Television insider Craig Bennett says the Neighbours star has been concerned for some time that AJ's Divine Truth would keep her 8 year old daughter from her after her ex partner Fabio Tolli joined the group.

Craig Bennett: I think her biggest fear is just for the safety and security of her daughter.

At the time of the Channel 7 report, I had only personally met Fabio (Kym's ex-partner) on three occasions, and did not know him well at all. I had not ever spent any personal time with him or his family. I had no knowledge of any interactions between Fabio and his ex-wife. I was only aware that he had a child from an ex-marriage, and I had seen his child at one of the seminars. I have only during the last year (2012) come to know Fabio much better. I fail to see how my interactions with Fabio in public at three seminars presented in Melbourne (all of which can be viewed in full on YouTube) can cause her daughter to be swept into "the Jesus cult". As I explained above, I do not have a cult, and I do not control the people who come to listen to me, nor their children. So it's impossible for Kym Valentine's daughter to be swept into the cult or kept away from her because of any of my actions.

In addition, I now know Fabio personally, and know that he has not prevented his ex-wife from spending time with her daughter, but rather, that his ex-wife has his daughter with her most of the time. So, the child has not been lost to some "divisive cult". She is still living with her own mother. When Fabio attends a seminar, he obviously brings his daughter with him if she is in his custody at the time, and she also seems to enjoy coming and spending time with the other children present. The children usually play while the parents listen, and there are no organized teachings just for the children; although children are able to listen if they want, they often feel boredom unless the spend time with the other children.

Channel 7 are also suggesting that children are in danger if they associate with me, which is a veiled suggestion to the public that I am dangerous to children. The many parents and children that know me know that I champion the safety of all children, and that children feel very safe around me.

"It's believed it may have contributed to Kym's health and emotional issues since separating from her husband and then being linked to the married Vince Colosimo. This morning she checked herself out of a private Melbourne hospital.

Craig Bennett: You could say she's hit rock bottom."

I have had no dealings with Kym Valentine, and it's an extraordinary leap that Channel 7 are making to imply that her ex husband Fabio attending three of my seminars is somehow responsible for some emotional problems that resulted not only from the breakdown of her relationship with her ex-husband, from whom she was already divorced when I met him, but also for the breakdown of her relationship with the actor Vince Colosimo. (According to Wikipedia the relationship with Vince Colosimo broke down and caused her to "hit rock bottom" in 2008, over 2 years before her ex-husband attended any of my seminars.)

"Already many of AJ's other followers have left their husbands, wives and families, searching out their true soulmates. Followers like Igor Shakhanov."

This is another lie by Channel 7. Igor Shakhanov is still with his wife, Lena. They both are friends of mine who donate their time by travelling around with and Mary and I filming and editing our seminars, book clubs, interviews and other events for DVDs and YouTube. This is another lie.

I do not teach that people should leave their relationships based on whether they think they are with their soulmate or not. I actually encourage people to stay in their relationships and to work through issues while they are in their relationships, in a loving manner. In fact I teach it is immoral to leave a relationship based on a thought that the person may not be your soulmate, or because they have a different spiritual belief system, since I teach that relationships should be based upon love. I described this in the talk "20120513 The Human Soul – Ethics and Morality". However, it is moral to leave a relationship if love is not felt between the parties, or if one party treats the other with rage, anger or other such emotions consistently.

Many persons who first hear the teachings about soulmates go through an emotional experience, where they do not know who their soulmate is, and they ask themselves that question. However, with regard to the teaching, I am only expressing the truth about how the soul is constructed as two halves, and that we each have another half who is actually the other half of ourselves. Many other teachings on earth believe this, right back from 1000's of years ago when people such as Aristotle presented such viewpoints, and yet they are not attacked for presenting such teachings.

Accusations about me preying on emotionally vulnerable people

Channel 7 then attempt to persuade the viewer that I am preying on emotionally vulnerable people because some of the people in my audiences experience their grief openly, which they show. These segments of the program were taken from the seminar that was attended by David Millikan and his cameraman, and this seminar can be viewed in full on YouTube [here](#) (20110319 The Human Soul – Addictions & Bribery, Fear, Threats & Blackmail). The program also showed this section with foreboding music being played in the background, a tool used to create a sense of fear and an overall negative impression in the viewing public of myself and Divine Truth.

"(From 'Addiction & Bribery, Fear, Threats and Blackmail' seminar) AJ: Fear, threats and blackmail (foreboding music being played in the background). I can feel that many of you are still in addictions with regard to your development towards God. (Clip of a woman, named Sarah, crying)"

A core part of the Divine Truth teachings is humility, which includes a willingness to experience all emotions - both positive and negative emotions (which I describe in the talk "20091114 Relationship with God – Humility"). Humility is essential in order to form a close relationship with God, because our entire relationship with God is based around emotions, and therefore if we choose not to feel our emotions, we are at the same time choosing not to connect to God. Many of us have many addictions – emotional as well as physical - in our lives that we use as ways to avoid feeling our emotions. In this talk I described ways in which we can identify those addictions so that we can feel our emotions to release them, and thereby grow closer to relationships with God, which in the long run will bring up a great deal of happiness.

The media have focused in this program on filming any person who is crying in the audience of my talks, in order to prey on the fears of the public about experiencing emotions. Storing negative emotions such as grief inside of us blocks our relationship with God and causes a lot of sickness and disease; and therefore it is important to release these emotions from us in order to form a closer relationship with God and become happier. On each occasion when the media showed an audience member crying, there were at least 100 to 200 other people in the audience who were sitting there quite happily, but the cameras did not show them because that would reduce the impact of the sensation that the media is attempting to create.

"(From 'Addiction & Bribery, Fear, Threats and Blackmail' seminar) AJ: Let yourself feel the disillusionment you feel (clip of a man called Alex crying). This disillusionment about the search."

The media have taken many of the clips out of context, in order to manipulate the public into thinking that I am creating a group of emotionally vulnerable people whom I wish to control. In this presentation I explained how we need to release all emotions that create pain within us in order to form a closer relationship with God. One of those emotions is disillusionment. Alex felt that he was disillusioned with the world and life, and I was encouraging him to feel that. If you watch the presentation in its unedited form, you will see that the audience was not all breaking down in tears as I made this statement. This is again a manipulative measure by Channel 7 using heavy editing to create a sensationalist story for their personal benefit.

"(From 'Addiction & Bribery, Fear, Threats and Blackmail' seminar) AJ: I will feed them with my truth... (Showing a girl called Nina crying)"

This quote was also taken out of context, and can be viewed in full on YouTube. I was actually speaking as if I was a spirit, not myself, and was explaining how people can be manipulated by spirits as sometimes spirits feed people with the spirit's version of the truth. We need to become aware of spirit manipulation and our addictions in order to identify and release the negative emotions within our souls if we want to form a close relationship with God. Again, the Channel 7's presentation of the material is totally manipulative.

Accusations about me taking money from people

"On the Divine Truth website calls for donations are made to help AJ and Mary travel overseas (Shows a website on screen that is not the Divine Truth website), most likely to recruit more followers."

During this part of Channel 7's presentation they show a website that is NOT our Divine Truth website. It is another site created by people that I know, that I have no control over. I do have a donations page on the Divine Truth website, but money is not solicited from people who listen to the Divine Truth. All of my presentations, and all of the Divine Truth that we distribute, are provided for free. While there is a donation box at the back of the room when I give seminars, there is no obligation for people to donate, and there is no collection. The donations page on the website provides a mechanism for people to donate to us if they want to.

Mary and I do live off the donations given by people, but we will also return donations to people if we feel that they are not given in the spirit of love or if there is any kind of requirement of us in return, since this is not a true gift. Nor do we accept donations from people who we know are short of money themselves. I give the gift of my time to others. Some of them feel to give me a gift in return, and the mechanism for that to happen is provided, but the gift is not solicited. Mary and I also declare these gifts as income to the government, and pay taxation on the gifts we receive, contrary to other people's claims.

We do rely on people's donations to travel to different locations around Australia and overseas, but there is no recruitment involved in this process – we simply travel to places where we have been invited to travel to, and when we have received enough donations to do so.

I am a qualified computing professional, and Mary is a qualified Occupational Therapist. If we do not receive enough gifts to survive, we are able to work in a different way to obtain income. However, at the moment, through the generosity of many of those who listen to our teachings,

we receive enough gifts from people to live and travel to teach the Divine Truth to others, free of charge. I challenge any person who criticizes me in this regard to setup their own life in the same manner, and see what emotions are challenged within themselves to live such a life, before they criticize Mary and I about how we receive funds to support our life.

In the first century, we also received donations. This is clearly expressed even in the Bible. It is interesting again that the Jesus of the first century is allowed to receive donations without criticism, but the modern day Jesus is treated as if he is untrustworthy for doing so. The media relies on the lack of knowledge within the general public about what the 1st century Jesus supposedly did as recorded in the Bible.

In addition, the media itself seems to only report on matters that will increase its own viewer base, and therefore potentially increase its own revenue through advertising. There is a general public fear about organizations taking money from individuals or about being ripped off financially, and I can understand why such fears exist when there are many persons who are willing to treat other people badly when it comes to financial matters. In my situation, the media only wishes to connect to this fear, rather than present the truth that I am an ethical man when it comes to financial matters, as all persons who deal with me financially will attest to.

Accusations about a doomsday prophecy

"And that is what has many here concerned with Miller already preaching of an apocalypse next year [in 2012]. Wilkesdale outside Kingaroy is the base chosen as God's safe place for a last stand."

I do not believe or teach that there will be any doomsday or apocalyptic end of the world. I also do not believe 2012 is a "special year". In fact, I have publicly expressed that I believe the future can be very good for all humanity, but that this will depend upon what humanity collectively chooses. I do feel that events will take place on the Earth that could be severe in terms of geographical changes, as I have stated in some of my seminars. However I do not believe that this is the end of the world, or that there will be a doomsday, or that these events are part of a Biblical Armageddon.

I believe that these changes happen cyclically to the Earth, and there is physical evidence for these changes occurring in the past. I must remind the reader, as I have reminded people every time I have talked about these subjects; that these are my opinions at this moment, and these opinions will obviously change as I become more progressed in love.

Some people who know me have moved to live in the region where I live, but I did not personally encourage or ask them to do so. I certainly did not manipulate them into thinking that it would be some kind of safe haven created by God for people during an apocalypse. I have told many people that they cannot be safe until they address their own fears, which attract unsafe events.

I encourage people to follow their desires, and suggest that they should be open to moving to any location where their desires may be fulfilled. I also teach that our souls create every event in our lives, and that it is impossible to "run away" from our Law of Attraction. So if we have fears within our souls about our safety during the potential Earth changes that may happen in the future, then these fears will attract events to us in order to expose them, so that we can release them and grow towards God. So it is impossible to escape from our fears by moving to a certain location, because they are carried within us, inside of our souls. I describe this in the talk "20111204 God's Laws – Law of Cause & Effect".

Conclusion

Of all of the media TV presentations in this initial wave of interest in May 2011, the Channel 7 'Today Tonight' TV program was the most malicious. There was a purposeful attempt by Channel 7 to present as many lies as possible, and, since they were concerned about the attention given to their rival, Channel 9's 'A Current Affair', they attempted to demonstrate to the public that they had been in contact with us before Channel 9. In doing so, they lied about their 'hidden' cameras, amongst many other things.

This TV program was the first of many attempts by Channel 7 to create a sensational story out of a large body of lies and fabrication. They are taking what they know has created media interest in the past, and also what they know are lies about my personal circumstances; including such references to doomsday cults, and are creating stories that are fictitious to manipulate the public into experiencing fears about me and my teachings. They are using these lies and manipulations as tools in an attempt to create a story that bears no relation to the actual truth, for the purpose of getting higher ratings and making money. They know these accusations are lies, because they spent over four twenty four hour days in my company, never observing anything that matched their own lies about me.

After this report was aired, we were attacked by many people who believed that the media would not lie. When we replied to these people that most of the information was untrue, most people refused to believe that the media could be so willing to lie directly without something being done about it. As a result, many people still believe these untruths, and we believe that this was the underlying motive of Channel 7, the 'Today Tonight' show, and the minister who was the interviewer, Mr David Millikan; to ensure that people would not listen to anything we teach by lying about what we teach, and by lying about their interactions with us.

Any person who is open to discovering the Truth will need to question the underlying motives that the media seems to have to distort the truth or present actual lies in order to maintain their power base. This seems to be a general problem in the media. I am personally looking forward to meeting a media professional who does not do this, since I believe now that such a person will be a rare find indeed.

At the moment, many members of the media and public are accusing me of the same things I was accused of in the first century, with the only difference being that they are using a different physical medium. This demonstrates how little things have really changed in 2000 years of human history. Hopefully change will begin to happen soon, when the general public realize they are being manipulated daily by the media, and desire to call to account the media for their dishonesty and manipulation. This is already happening in other countries, and I believe it also needs to happen here in Australia.

I believe in order to do this the public will need to become more willing to face and accept truth themselves, rather than having a preference to believe lies. In addition, the public will need to work through the emotion of forgiveness when they hear the truth, because, at the moment, there is a general desire in the public to punish people who lie, rather than just accept a sincere apology for the lie.
