This is a response to the Channel 9 program "A Current Affair", which broadcast a series of three presentations over three nights in May 2011.

Response

The series of programs that were presented by Channel 9 over the three days became increasingly more sensationalized as they progressed as the channel attempted to draw in more viewers in order to make more money. During these presentations Channel 9 have distorted the truth by presenting a series of lies about Mary and I and the teachings that we provide for free. They have recruited so called experts to comment about us, when they actually know nothing about us. They have regularly used methods such as playing foreboding music in the background, or using computer graphic visuals to generate negative connotations, to create a

mood that will promote an association between a feeling of fear and suspicion in the viewers and myself, Mary and the Divine Truth. While they claim that I am running some kind of controlling and manipulating cult, Channel 9 themselves are actually doing what they are accusing me of, by attempting to control and manipulate of the public's response for their own benefit.

Accusations about me being a "cult leader"

"The Australian cult leader who calls himself 'Jesus Christ.'"

The presumption that Channel 9 are making is that just because I am calling myself Jesus then I must also be running a cult. The only people who compare me to cult leaders are the media themselves, and this is very clear later on in the program when they interview two of my friends who regularly attend my seminars, Angela and Robert Griffiths, both of whom clearly state that I do not run a cult. However the media have chosen to ignore the comments of people who actually know me, and instead label me as a cult leader in order to create fear and suspicion in the viewing public.

My seminars are open to anyone who wishes to come to listen to Divine Truth, and people are free to come and go as they please during them. I do not charge for any of the seminars that I give, since I believe that Divine Truth should always be provided for free. People who come to my seminars do not need to stay for the duration of my talks and they can leave at any time. There is no "membership" or any other binding nature of the Divine Truth. All of the material that I teach is freely available on the Divine Truth website, as well as the Divine Truth channel on YouTube, and DVDs and external hard drives containing our material are copied and distributed for free. So there is no secrecy in any of the material that I present, which the media wishes to suggest by using the term "cult", in order to make me appear secretive and controlling, which I am not.

I have very little dealings day to day with most of the people who attend my seminars. So I do not attempt to control anyone who comes to my seminars and listens to my presentations on YouTube or on DVDs. I actively encourage people who listen to my seminars to follow their own desires in harmony with Love and Truth, rather than attempt to have any kind of dependency on myself. This is vital if they are going to grow in their relationship with God. I describe this in the talk "20100412 The Human Soul - Taking Personal Responsibility".

Having any kind of control over people is also in total opposition to what I teach about God's Law of Free Will, since whenever somebody tries to control another person, they are immediately out of harmony with the Law of Free Will, and this incurs a consequence for their soul condition, taking them further away from God. Since my main objective in life is to grow in love and to grow towards God, this is a direct contradiction of my teachings and how I live my life. These teachings are described in the talk "20120421 The Human Soul - The Gift of Free Will" and "20120422 The Human Soul - The Gift of Free Will".

"Allan John Miller is based in Queensland's Bible belt but is now on the move, spreading his web around the country."

I do not have a "web", as Channel 9 put it. This is another attempt by the media to imply that I am controlling and manipulative. As I have explained above I do not control anybody who attends my seminars, and I do not control what happens to any of the material that I produce, since it is not copyrighted and is all given away for free.

"He's the ex-Jehovah's witness turned self styled religious leader with a growing base of followers..."

Channel 9 are making the leap that because I teach Divine Truth to whomever wishes to listen then I am a religious leader. This is an attempt by them to make it appear that I am looking for power and control over others, but neither of these things are true. While I do teach people about spirituality and how to grow in love, I am not a religious leader. Just because I am sharing with people how to connect with God directly, and how to form a close personal relationship with God without any intermediary, including myself, this does not mean that I wish to have a religion or a religious following. Most religions install a hierarchy of intermediaries between people and God, and I cannot agree with these actions. I believe the principles of Divine Truth can be introduced into all religions, and I do not wish to be the leader of any religion.

It is impossible for me to be an intermediary between any person and God, because the only way to form a close personal relationship with God is to do so directly, just as we cannot form a close personal relationship with any other person with a third party as an intermediary. I actively discourage people who listen to my seminars from focusing on me rather than God, and in fact find it very distasteful when people attempt to direct their worship towards me, rather than towards our true Parent and Creator, God. All of the people who know me never attempt to worship me. I also have no intention of developing a new religion because I believe there are already too many religions on the planet that are fighting with one another.

"The headquarters is near Kingaroy in Queensland."

There is no Divine Truth "headquarters". Mary and I live in a very humble two bedroom house on a 40 acre property 36kms outside of Kingaroy. Our home is similar to anyone else's home in the area. Nobody else lives with us although occasionally we do have visitors to our home. We do not even have fences around our property. We took them all down as some wildlife were getting caught in them. Our property is just our private home. For some unknown reason all of the media refer to our home as the "headquarters" or the "compound".

"But its leader [AJ] makes no apologies for steering others onto his path. No matter the consequences."

This is another fabrication by the media to create the impression that I am controlling and manipulating people to come and listen to me by "steering" them onto this path. I respect the free will of others, and have no desire to steer people to believe any of my teachings. I do not even advertise my teachings at present. I teach that God loves all of his children equally, whether they decide to form a relationship with God or not. So it would be hypocritical of me to not behave in the same manner. I respect the will of others whether or not they choose to follow a spiritual or religious path, or follow the "Way" that I teach which is not a religion but rather a way of living life in harmony with love.

I also fail to see how the "consequences" of following a path that loves can be negative. Surely most sincere persons on the planet wish to become more loving in their own day to day interactions with others, and this would result in many positive outcomes for all members of society that interact with such people.

Through the Divine Truth teachings I actively discourage any person from steering or manipulating any other person, and do not do this myself, since it would degrade my soul condition. Since my teachings are all based around how we as individuals, and how the planet as a whole, can grow in love, this is a complete contradiction to the message I am actually presenting. I describe this in detail in the talk "20120218 and 20120219 Lessons in Love – Love

has Power over Evil". However the media just skip over this, as they skip over almost all of the details of my teachings, because it does not suit the story that they wish to create.

And from the second presentation:

"AJ Miller and his partner are touring the country, drumming up followers."

And in the third presentation:

"AJ Miller tells anyone who'll listen...."

Mary and I are not "drumming up followers" and we do not force the teachings onto people who do not wish to hear them. However, we do talk to "anyone who will listen". We only travel to places where we have been invited by people to speak for two reasons. The first reason is because we have no desire to present a seminar to people who have no desire to listen to us. In the first century I taught to not give truth to those who do not wish to receive it, unless you are already in a personal interaction with the person, because it is harming the other person's free will (which I explain in the talk "20091114 Relationship with God – Humility"). The other reason that Mary and I only travel to places where we have been invited is because we do all of our presentations for free. Therefore we are not able to travel to a location unless the people who have invited us, or some other people who are interested in others hearing the Truth, donate the funds in order for us to travel.

"Divine Truth followers haven't just established groups in Tasmania, Victoria, Queensland, and Western Australia, they're influence is spreading around the world. The sect has members throughout Europe, Sweden, the United Kingdom and Greece, where a global summit is planned for later this year. There's also branches in the United States, in Brevard County, Florida, and in the Las Vegas, with plans to spread the Divine Gospel even further." (Played with more foreboding music and with the locations being highlighted on a map as if targets for some kind of military exercise)

Here Channel 9 are playing music and showing computer visuals in order to create a sense that I am conducting some kind of military operation, preparing for world domination. (This I find to be very amusing). I merely wish to teach the truth to anybody who wishes to listen, as I state when I am being interviewed during the program. There was no global summit; this is a use of terminology by the media to create a sense that we are somehow attempting to take over the world, when we were merely teaching people how to grow in love. When Mary and I travel, our travel to any location around the world is dependent upon invitations from people who wish to hear us speak, and are dependent upon donations in order for us to be able to fund those travels.

We are not the leaders of a religious sect or religion. We have no religious structure or organisation at all. Just because I claim that I am Jesus, people should not assume that I am attempting to set up a religion, cult, religious following, or any other hierarchy that other people have created. I am just teaching any person who wants to listen about how to have a personal relationship with God.

In the third presentation:

"In recent days 'A Current Affair' has shown how up to 40 disciples of the Divine Truth have moved to southern Queensland to be near their leader, to follow his teachings."

I could not say that I have any disciples, since, at the moment, no person I know who has been coming to the seminars I give is actually practicing completely what I am teaching. I do not see people who listen to what I teach as disciples. I see them as my friends. I also find it interesting that on one hand the media wishes to claim that I have an "inner core" of people surrounding me, of around 40 disciples, when at the same time they are saying that I am dangerous to the entire world. The inconsistency of the reports attempting to show that no-one in their right mind would listen, and that there are only a few people who actually listen to my teachings, while at the same time claiming that I have begun a "dangerous and destructive" sect potentially affecting many; besides being untrue, is just an attempt to manipulate the public with false information.

The reality is that I have no idea how many people listen to my teachings, since they are free on YouTube. We have also given away over one hundred thousand DVD's, and since there is no copyright on anything that we produce, we do not know how many of those have been copied and re-produced.

Some people who have known me for a few years have moved to live in the region where I live, but I did not personally encourage or ask them to do so, and I have not personally visited many of them in their own homes mostly because I do not have the time to do so when Mary and I are home. These people have purchased their own properties near me without ever discussing their intentions or reasons for doing so beforehand. We see very little of them when we are home near Kingaroy.

In the first presentation:

"Helen Pomerick: The cults that caused the cult experts in America the greatest concern were the cults where the cult leader called himself Jesus."

Channel 9 then attempt to enforce the idea that I run a cult by bringing in a cult awareness spokesperson, Helen Pomerick, to make comments about myself and the Divine Truth that I teach. However Ms. Pomerick has no knowledge of my teachings and is basing all of her comments on her own personal problems that she had with the Christian Fellowship group, which has nothing to do with Divine Truth, and so is therefore not a reliable source of information about me at all.

Ms Pomerick has never met me, and is therefore basing her comments on her previous experiences with other people, who perhaps were cult leaders, and drawing false assumptions about me from that. This is another attempt by the media to distort the truth by making illogical links between myself and other cults, when the so called experts they question are not familiar with me and my teachings. When people who do know me who are interviewed, such as Angela and Robert Griffiths, they categorically state that I do not run a cult. Just because I claim that I am Jesus, it is not logical to assume that I am going to behave the same as every other person who claims they are Jesus.

They then follow Ms Pomerick with another cult expert, Michael Bachelor, in the third program. Michael Bachelor also has never met me, and knows nothing about the Divine Truth, and is therefore also making judgments about myself and what I teach with no basis whatsoever. This is clear in the following comments that he makes:

"Michael Bachelor: People like him are very good at getting into people's psyche. Plus, you know, he and his partner are sexy, they're young, they're charismatic."

Since Michael Bachelor has never met me, it is very difficult for him to know what I am like, and therefore be able to compare me to other people with his comment, "people like him..." This is a generalisation based on no foundation of truth. I do not attempt to get into people's psyches – I merely teach the Divine Truth to people who wish to listen. They can do what they wish with that information, and I have no investment in whether they do wish to implement the teachings in their lives or not. Many who I have regularly seen at my seminars have not followed my teachings personally even though they have been fascinated by the information.

Mr Bachelor also demonstrates how little he knows about me since he calls me young, when I'm actually over 2000 years old, and I am 49 years old in this life (please do not take offense if you are older, and believe yourself to be young). I do not believe I am "sexy", as Mary knows, but there is little I can do if others believe that about me. I feel Mary is beautiful, but that is my own personal opinion. (laughs)

One of the benefits of implementing Divine Truth teachings in our lives is that we improve our soul condition, which in turn improves our physical health and enables our bodies to repair themselves from the damage of aging and illness that is created by our soul injuries. I am hopefully demonstrating this and that is part of my purpose of returning – to demonstrate the potential of the human soul when we form a close relationship with God. I describe this in the talk "20120616 Relationship with God – The Eternal Benefits".

"Michael Bachelor: And it's really that idea that you can be convinced to do really strange and weird things by somebody that you believe in this case is the second coming of Jesus."

Mr Bachelor is making a sweeping statement here to elicit fear and suspicion in the viewing audience, without actually saying anything specific. He implies that I am convincing people to do "really strange and weird things", but he doesn't actually refer to any strange and weird things that I have convinced people to do. That is because I do not convince people to do strange and weird things; I instead encourage them to be more truthful and loving, which isn't strange and weird at all. And since many of the people I present to have a lot of difficulty in implementing my teachings and actually becoming more loving and truthful, I have yet to actually even convince them of that.

"Jessica Solkowski was introduced to the Divine Truth and AJ Miller at the age of 12.

Jessica: What he teaches isn't really stereotypical cult. Like when you think about the big American ones, it has more free choice involved which makes you believe it even more."

I met Jessica Solkowski in Western Australia at the home of a friend of mine, John Kreppold who has since passed. She was visiting John with her mother. I made no attempt to introduce her to the teachings of Divine Truth. Her mother asked me questions in a private setting which I subsequently answered. When my friend died, I stayed with Jessica and her mother in a spare bedroom during the time of his death and funeral, so I got to know the family well during that time. It is interesting that even Jessica stated that I am not teaching "stereotypical cult" teachings.

The reason Jessica says that what I teach isn't a stereotypical cult is because it isn't a cult. I encourage people to enable the free will of others in their belief systems, as I have explained above, and am happy whether they agree with me or not about what I teach. That is why there is more free choice – because I do not have any desire to control the choices of those who listen to the Divine Truth. It is up to people personally how much they personally embrace of the teachings I present.

Accusations that I claim I am God or part of God

Channel 9 make a large number of comments and assumptions during the presentations that because I say I am Jesus then I am claiming to be God, as follows:

"AJ Miller... who claims to be nothing less than the son of God."

And later on:

"He's the self styled preacher who claims the ultimate moral high ground."

And in the third presentation:

"AJ Miller tells anyone who'll listen that he's the real son of God."

Channel 9 are making the assumption that because I say I am Jesus and "nothing less than the son of God", they are implying that I am different from other people. They also accused me during the interview that I am saying that I am actually God. They are basing this erroneous assumption on falsities contained within the Bible. I have never made any claims that I am God, or part of God. However in the first century I did become Divine in nature, when I become at-one with God.

Since then many people have reached this condition in the spirit world, but they also do not claim to be God. So I see myself as a brother and equal to all other humans on Earth and in the spirit world. I am a son of God, just as every human on Earth is a son or daughter of God, as I clearly state in the second and third presentations.

In addition, I do not claim any moral high ground at any time. When people ask me questions surrounding morality (sexual and otherwise) I state to them clearly what I have personally learned about these matters. I also do not expect others to follow the same moral code as I do myself. I ask them to measure whether something is moral through their personal connection with God. I do present information about ethics, and the general principle of "doing unto others what you would like them to do to you" as a measure of loving actions. Please see the seminar "20120513 The Human Soul - Ethics & Morality" for more information about that.

"The Australian cult leader who calls himself 'Jesus Christ'"

I also do not proclaim myself to be "Jesus Christ". In the first century I reached at-onement with God, and in that process I became "Christed". However I have not yet reached that condition of love since I have returned to Earth, and therefore do not use that term about myself. I am just the man, Jesus. I hope to become "Christ" again at some time in the future when I have worked through my own personal issues surrounding the lack of love within me. The media are using this term as a way to imply that I am a deity, and putting myself above others, when in fact I teach that I am a human being, just like everybody else on Earth and in the spirit world, and that we are all equal children of God. We can all become "Christed".

"10 years ago Helen Pomerick was ex-communicated from a group known as a Christian Fellowship. She hasn't seen her children since and is now the spokesperson for the cult awareness and information centre."

Helen: When a cult leader, or any leader of any group claims that they are Jesus, they elevate themselves to that Divine status and when they are of the Divine, when they are

in fact God here on earth, God incarnate, then you can't question them because to question them, you're actually questioning God."

I feel compassion for a person who has been excommunicated from a group, since I had that experience in my own life. I do not recommend that any religion practices excommunication. I personally do not lead a religion or religious sect, and so, there is no excommunication in the teachings of Divine Truth. If a person is treating another in an unkind or unloving manner then I suggest that the person being treated badly needs to step away from the interaction if possible. If that is not possible, then the person who is acting unkindly should be removed until such time as they are capable of acting kindly again.

I do not require people to agree with me, and in fact many people who interact with me daily do not agree with me on many subjects. However, they continue to treat me kindly even though they do not agree, and so I continue my association with them. It is clear from many of the presentations that I have given that I am open to being questioned and disagreed with regularly. I do not suggest that if people disagree with me or question me that they are going "against God" or that they will be punished by God in any way, which is what Ms. Pomerick implying. (I also feel that even the belief in a punishing God is completely in error and actually blasphemous against God. I do not believe God directly or personally punishes anyone when they go against God's Laws.). This is another attempt by the media to portray me as controlling and manipulative, when they themselves are attempting to manipulate and control the public through their suggestions.

The issue of my identity

Channel 9 then go to great lengths to suggest that I have brainwashed the people who listen to me into believing that I am Jesus, and that I am lying about my identity.

"Yet the man himself says his claim to be the son of God isn't even a big deal, no matter who believes it.

AJ: The significance that you place on it, if I can suggest to you, is much greater than the significance that I place on it.

Nick: I place significance on it in one critical respect.

AJ: Yep.

Nick: And that is that it may influence people who are vulnerable to believe in something that's not true. And I'd suggest to you that what you're saying to me is not true. You are not Jesus Christ.

AJ: Yeah.

Nick Coe: You are not THE son of God.

AJ: Yep.

Nick Coe: And you don't remember anything from 2000 years ago because you weren't here.

AJ: Right. And that is your opinion and you're allowed to have your opinion. And you've got the free will to have that opinion. And you've made that opinion without much investigation I might add."

I encourage everybody who attends my seminars to discover truth for themselves, and not to take my word or the media's word for it. I teach that to discover truth we need to learn it emotionally, rather than intellectually, and this involves a process of releasing our emotional errors first before we can receive God's Truth on any matter. I teach that we must learn to experiment with what may be 'truth', and make mistakes, before we can discover the actual truth. In fact I regularly stress in my seminars that knowing the Truth intellectually is completely ineffective at changing our lives, because we have to learn the truth in our hearts before we change our lives and become more loving.

An example of one of the talks where I describe how to determine truth is "20120512 The Human Soul – Logic, Emotions and Truth". I encourage people to use a process of experimentation as well as intellectual discernment to discover emotional truth. So while many people who listen to my seminars think that may be that I am Jesus because of the quality and effectiveness of the Divine Truth that I teach them, none of them have yet resolved this issue in their hearts. What I suggested to Nick Coe was that he was also making a judgement based on no investigation of his own – either intellectually or emotionally – and therefore was not in a position to state what the Divine Truth about my identity is. He is only making an assumption, which he has the right to do. But this is not a very wise action if he wishes to actually know the truth.

I also do not influence people who are vulnerable. The people who attend my seminars are generally from all walks of life, and many are very intelligent and well educated people, who are highly able to decide for themselves whether I am teaching the truth or not.

"His followers believe he's the original son of God, Jesus Christ himself. Even his own literature promotes himself as someone who's returned to earth after 2000 years to teach us all what he calls the Divine Truth."

And later on in the first presentation:

"Lauren: AJ Miller has said that he's a reincarnation of Jesus. Are you convinced?"

Angela: I have no reason to believe that he's not.

Lauren: It's a pretty big claim to make.

Rob: He's feels people's souls. It's quite obvious."

And later on in the first presentation:

"Raj Miles and Suzanna Stallard also believe beyond doubt that AJ and Mary are Jesus and Mary Magdalene."

And in the second presentation:

"Lauren: You both believe that Alan and Mary are Jesus and Mary? Mary Magdalene?"

Raj: I'm afraid so.

Suz: Unfortunately.

Raj: (laughs)

Suz: (laughs)"

And in the second presentation:

"AJ Miller's claim to be Jesus Christ might almost be laughable if nobody believed him. The problem is many people do."

The media are also making the assumption that most of the people who listen to me believe that I am Jesus, when in fact at the moment very few of them actually do. Even those interviewed in the TV program did not say for certain that they know that I am Jesus. The media has made this statement in order to create an impression that I have brainwashed the people who come to listen to my talks, when I have not. The people who come to listen to me are drawn to the Divine Truth that I teach because they can feel the truth resonate inside of themselves and they can see how effective the teachings are at changing their lives for the better.

After watching the material, many people do have an initial feeling that I am Jesus. However, over a period of time, that feeling usually diminishes and is replaced by doubt, because it is very difficult for an individual person to accept everything I state in my seminars without there being some resistance.

Raj Miles and Suzanne Stallard are two friends of mine, and they are not convinced that I am Jesus, and neither are Angela and Robert Griffiths or any other person who attends my seminars. When Raj and Suzanne said that they believed that I am Jesus in the second program, they were basing their answer on their intellectual belief rather than their emotional belief, which I feel they are personally yet to resolve. They go through times when they believe I am Jesus, and then, they also sometimes get angry with what I say.

"Michael Bachelor: I think people believe him because they want to believe him."

Most of the people who come to my seminars would rather that I did not say that I am Jesus, since they are well aware of the ostracism and judgment it can create in their lives when they say to their friends and families that they are spending their weekend listening to Jesus giving a seminar. Almost everyone I have met, including Mary, has firstly criticized me for saying that I am Jesus. In addition, almost everyone I have met have said that they would prefer I did not say I was Jesus, because then the Divine Truth I teach would be more acceptable to them and their families.

Sometimes, during presentations, when I am asked the direct question as to whether I am Jesus or nor, I have had over half of the audience immediately get up and walk out when I have answered the question in the affirmative. So, in actual fact, almost everyone I meet, and everyone who comes along to my presentations, would prefer me to never mention anything about being Jesus. They feel my stating I am Jesus is a drawback, and causes many people to react negatively. I have received more personal criticism about this one issue than any teaching I have ever presented. I believe much of the media attack only comes from this issue; that I am stating I am Jesus.

This is illustrated by the embarrassed laughs from Raj and Suzanne when questioned on the subject. They would prefer that I was not Jesus. Even Mary attempted to persuade me that I am not Jesus when we first met. Despite this, many people find the teachings that I present

extremely uplifting because it is very rewarding to discover the truths about things that you have been searching for answers to all of your life. For this reason, many people ignore my claim of being Jesus, and instead, just listen to the teachings I present. I am completely fine with this reaction.

"Michael Bachelor: People like him are very good at getting into people's psyche. Plus, you know, he and his partner are sexy, they're young, they're charismatic. It's easy to believe."

It is clear from the fact that most of the people who attend my seminars do not actually believe that I am Jesus that it is not "easy to believe", as Michael Bachelor says. In fact, almost everyone I know finds it almost impossible to believe I am Jesus. The media are again trying to suggest that I have brainwashed the people who listen to my teachings, by suggesting that they are gullible and believe everything I say without question, when in fact the opposite is true.

"Jessica: I'm completely convinced that he thinks he actually is. Like I don't think that he thinks he's lying anymore."

I have never lied about my identity, now or in the past, when I have told people who I am. I never began this process by firstly lying, and then gradually coming to a place of accepting my own lies. I do tell people who I am because I believe in the importance of truth, and understand how important truth is to develop our relationship with God. If I did not truly feel I am Jesus, I have enough personal integrity to relinquish the claim. In addition, it would be unethical of me to present the Truths I teach but withhold the Truth about my own identity just to make it easier on myself and others to accept. I do not believe in misleading people by initially withholding what I believe is the truth, only to disclose what I believe is the truth later. To do so would be purposefully misleading.

The issue of how I met Mary

"Nick Coe: As a lay person I'm trying to understand what the odds are, you as someone who claims to be Jesus Christ, could meet Mary Magdalene in her parent's lounge room 2000 years after you died. Can you understand how I might just struggle with that a bit?"

AJ: When you understand the full Divine Truth about the soul and its power and desire and its power and also the fact that we're not... we've lived one life..."

This is an example of how the media heavily edit my answers in order to manipulate the public into thinking that I am claiming something that is either highly unlikely or impossible. I gave the full explanation during the interview but Channel 9 have not shown this because broadcasting any of my answers in full would weakened their efforts to falsely portray me as some kind of lunatic, and not the logical person that I actually am.

The Divine Truth about the soul is that it constructed in two halves, and splits in two at the time of incarnation. Therefore every single person has one other person who is the other half of their soul. The attraction between the two halves of the soul is the strongest attraction in the universe between created beings, and so most people are drawn to meet their soul mate while on Earth. However most people are not able to recognise their soul mate because of the emotional injuries that we have inside of our souls that prevent us seeing our own and our soul mate's true nature, and these emotional injuries often push the two halves apart. Before I met Mary during this incarnation I removed most of the injuries in my soul towards my other half, and therefore the attraction between the two halves of our soul was very strong, which led me

to meeting her in her parent's lounge room. (I describe this in the talks "20100123 and 20101024 The Human Soul – The Soul-Mate Relationship".)

Implications that I take money from people who listen to me

"They're also free to donate to the cause (showing the donation box at the back of the seminar) but others have reservations about what he's actually teaching." (This was shown with foreboding music being played in the background)

All of my presentations, and all of the Divine Truth that we distribute, are provided for free. While there is a donation box at the back of the room when I give seminars, there is no obligation for people to donate, and there is no collection. Mary and I do live off the donations given by people, but we will also return donations to people if we feel that they are not given in the spirit of love or if there is any kind of requirement of us in return, since this is not a true gift. Nor do we accept donations from people who we know are short of money themselves. I give the gift of my time to others. Some of them feel to give me a gift in return, and the mechanism for that to happen is provided, but the gift is not solicited. Mary and I also declare these gifts as income to the government, and pay taxation on the gifts we receive, contrary to other people's claims.

In the first century, we also received donations. This is clearly expressed even in the Bible. It is interesting again that the Jesus of the first century is allowed to receive donations without criticism, but the modern day Jesus is treated as if he is untrustworthy for doing so.

In addition, the media itself seems to only report on matters that will increase its own viewer base, and therefore potentially increase its own revenue through advertising. There is a general public fear about organizations taking money from individuals or about being ripped off financially, and I can understand why such fears exist when there are many persons who are willing to treat other people badly when it comes to financial matters. In my situation, the media only wishes to connect to this fear, rather than present the truth that I am an ethical man when it comes to financial matters, as all persons who deal with me financially will attest to.

"This is where weekly Divine Truth meetings are held (The reporter is at the learning centre). A 600 acre book bought in 2009 by half a dozen followers including Angela and Robert Griffith. They tell us AJ Miller plans to build a community centre, and accommodation here for visitors wanting to learn more about his beliefs.

Lauren: And who will fund this?

Angela: Well the same people who've been donating all the way along. It's people's desire to contribute."

The 600 acre property being referred to is a privately owned property 2kms from where Mary and I personally live. Mary and I do not own this property, nor do we have day to day access or direction over the property in question. The current owners have all decided to attempt to run the property in harmony with the constitution of the God's Way Of Love organisation, and Mary and I provide advice when it is asked for. This is a decision the current owners collectively made, and which they can also individually or collectively rescind.

As far as we know, weekly Divine Truth meetings are not held at this property. We hold Divine Truth meetings wherever we are invited, and we have in the past occasionally had meetings at

this property, just as we have occasionally had meetings in people's private homes, in fields, and in hired meeting halls. We attempt to have meetings with people wherever we are invited.

And in the second program:

"But AJ Miller has gone to the trouble of setting up a company called God's Way of Love limited. He says it's a not for profit organization with he and his partner as directors. The ATO wouldn't tell us if it enjoys tax free status like many other so-called religious groups."
(Shown with foreboding music being played in the background)

Myself and Mary have established the God's Way of Love organization with the objective of teaching Divine Truth, Divine Love, God's Laws and Humility in action in every practical aspect of life. The objectives and principles of this organization are available for anybody to read if they wish, and can be found in the on constitution on the God's Way of Love website [here](http://www.godswayoflove.org/) (<http://www.godswayoflove.org/>). The media attempt to portray us as some kind of secret organization, or "cult", when in fact all of our objectives and teachings are open and freely available for everybody to view on the Internet.

At the time that this program went to air, the God's Way of Love organization was in the process of applying for not-for-profit status. However we have since changed the constitution, and will not be running the organization as a non-profit organization, for the reasons stated in the presentation "20111008 God's Way Of Love - Constitution Changes", which is downloadable on the God's Way Of Love YouTube Channel. The latest version of the constitution is not yet on the website, because I am yet to complete editing it. We cannot obtain non-profit status as a religion, because we are not a religion and have no intention of setting up a religion.

Currently there are several properties that are located around the world, in Australia and Sweden at present, that other people personally own and manage, which Mary and myself visit occasionally at the request of the owners of those properties. The owners wish to bring their properties into more harmony with what I teach, and so they ask us for our advice about the running of these properties. These people do not donate the property to the God's Way Of Love organization, nor to myself or Mary. They continue to own the property and manage it how they see fit.

However, they have requested that the God's Way of Love organization, and Mary and I specifically, give them personal advice. They wish to use their properties with the objective that they are used as a place to demonstrate the principles of God's Love in practice. Mary and I do not own the properties, but rather we advise practices that can be done on those properties to improve and restore the ecosystems in a way that is harmonious with Divine Truth. I have described this in the talk "20111008 God's Way of Love – Constitution Changes". The owners of these properties can stop following our teachings at any time without any penalty of any kind. They have and retain complete ownership and control over their own properties.

Implications that I have told many people that they are Mary Magdalene

"We've made contact with an ex-girlfriend of AJ Miller who confirmed for us that he'd also referred to her as Mary Magdalene, even before he'd started claiming to be the son of God."

I have on one occasion, over 5 years before I met Mary Luck, thought that another woman was my soul mate, but after I worked through some more of my emotional injuries I discovered that this was not the case. Other people have told me that other women are my soul mate, but, once

I met them, I knew they were not. Since that time, I have not felt that anyone was my soul mate other than Mary Luck. In addition, I had remained celibate for a period of over 4 years after I had personally resolved that the woman I believed was my soul mate was not. There is the suggestion that I say to women they are my soul mate in order to have sex with them, and this is not true. This is just another way the media attempt to discredit what I am teaching.

I never claimed the other woman was Mary Magdalene before I personally claimed to be Jesus. Since I believed this woman was my soulmate before I claimed I was Jesus, once I discovered and could personally accept my own identity and the actual identity of my soulmate, I then assumed she must be my soulmate, Mary Magdalene. However, after working through other emotional issues I faced, I came to see that she was not my soulmate, and that I was mistaken. I then lived alone for a period of 4 years working through different emotional issues that prevented me from meeting my soulmate, and after than time I met Mary again.

Accusations of about doomsday prophecies

(Clip shown from the movie "2012") *The fact is AJ Miller doesn't believe any of us even have a future. That we should all prepare for a massive worldwide calamity next year, one which will put the entire planet in peril. He even refers to a Hollywood blockbuster movie, helping paint for his disciples a graphic picture of what doomsday might look like.*

(Clip taken from the Fear Revisited seminar) *AJ: There's the movie 2012, right? Everyone I suggest you see it. Everyone. A lot of the events portrayed in the movie are similar to the kind of events that will be occurring."*

And later on, in the third presentation:

(Shows a clip from the movie "2012") *But it's the prophecies which have most angered many of Australia's religious leaders, AJ Miller insists that the world will come to and end next year. He even refers to a Hollywood movie to reinforce the point.*

(Clip taken from Fear Revisited DVD) *AJ: A lot of the events portrayed in the movie are similar to the kind of events that will be occurring. A lot of this stuff is very much coming from the spirit world at the moment in order to bring up the awareness of the human race into what's going to happen to come prepared."*

I do not believe or teach that there will be any doomsday or apocalyptic end of the world. I also do not believe 2012 is a "special year". In fact, I have publicly expressed that I believe the future can be very good for all humanity, but that this will depend upon what humanity collectively chooses. I do feel that events will take place on the Earth that could be severe in terms of geographical changes, as I state later on in the television program. However I do not believe that this is the end of the world, or the end of human civilisation or life. However, I do believe that the Earth will change a lot over the coming years, and at this point in time I still believe that some countries may completely disappear and other countries will change completely.

I believe that these changes happen cyclically to the Earth, and there is physical evidence for these changes occurring in the past. I do not believe there will be a doomsday, or that these events are part of a Biblical Armageddon. I must remind the reader, as I have reminded people every time I have talked about these subjects; that these are my opinions at this moment, and these opinions will obviously change as I become more progressed in love.

My teachings focus on encouraging people to release their fears by experiencing them, since our fears prevent us from forming a close relationship with God. So I encourage people to focus on all of their fears, such as fears about what other people think of them, or fears about speaking the truth, as well as external fears such as fears of what changes might happen to the Earth in the future.

The media have taken a clip of a presentation where I was encouraging people to focus on their fears about Earth changes and have presented it out of context in order to manipulate the public into thinking that I have formed a doomsday cult, so that they can liken me to people in the past who actually have formed doomsday cults. In fact I have spent very little time in my seminars talking about Earth changes. Out of approximately 700 hours of presentations that are currently on YouTube, I have probably only spoken about Earth changes for a total of about 5 or 6 hours. The talk where I encouraged people to focus on their fears, which is the clip shown in the presentation, can be viewed in full on YouTube and is entitled "20091024 The Human Soul – Fear Revisited".

"ACA's been told some disciples have moved there [to near where I live] because they've been warned that next year's disaster, as foretold by AJ Miller, would turn Wilkesdale into Australia's new waterfront paradise."

First of all, I live in Wilkesdale, not "Wilkesdale" as Channel 9 have stated. Secondly, and as I have mentioned above, some people who know me have moved to live in the region where I live, but I did not personally encourage or ask them to do so. I certainly did not manipulate them into thinking that it would be some kind of waterfront paradise that would be a safe haven from any potential Earth changes in the future, as Channel 9 are implying. I do not personally believe this. I have heard others jokingly say such things, but it is not something I personally believe.

I encourage people to follow their desires, and suggest that they should be open to moving to any location where their desires may be fulfilled. I also teach that our souls create every event in our lives, and that it is impossible to "run away" from our Law of Attraction. So if we have fears within our souls about our safety during the potential Earth changes that may happen in the future, then these fears will attract events to us in order to expose them, so that we can release them and grow towards God. So it is impossible to escape from our fears by moving to a certain location, because they are carried within us, inside of our souls. I describe this in the talk "20111204 God's Laws –Law of Cause & Effect".

The issue of experiencing emotions

In the second presentation:

"Neighbours claim they regularly hear screams coming from the leader's home, an exercise he says helps release emotional injuries from his follower's childhoods."

Lauren: Has there been talk about it within the community here?

Female neighbour: A little bit, yeah. Just in the street mostly. That's all we find that people talk about amongst themselves and what they're up to and hear the screams and what can we do and...

Male neighbour: It sounds distressing at some times.

Female neighbour: It does. It's quite disturbing actually."

And in the first presentation:

"Female neighbour: We've been a little bit worried about it because we hear them screaming fairly regularly."

A core part of the Divine Truth teachings is humility, which includes a willingness to experience all emotions - both positive and negative emotions (which I describe in the talk "20091114 Relationship with God – Humility"). Humility is essential in order to form a close relationship with God, because our entire relationship with God is based around emotions, and therefore if we choose not to feel our emotions, we are at the same time choosing not to connect to God.

Most of us have very intense negative emotions such as rage and terror within our souls that need to be fully experienced to be released, and the full experience of these types of emotions often involves screaming, or being in rage or angry. I encourage people to experience these emotions within the privacy of their own homes. Mary and I do this in the privacy of our own home. In doing so we are not aiming any of these negative emotions towards others, but are releasing the emotions in a loving way that does not harm other people or the environment.

Since society has so much fear and judgment about fully experiencing and expressing emotions, which is illustrated by the fact that my neighbours find screaming distressing, Channel 9 have included these comments in order to provoke fear in the viewing public and to create a negative impression of my character. They have not investigated the benefits of experiencing emotions in this way, and the fact that many similar techniques are widely used as psychological treatments in Western medicine. Of course they have also edited out any positive comments that my neighbours had to say about me i.e. that I always treat them in a loving manner, which is partly a result of my willingness to experience my emotions. I know that many of my neighbours have stated positive things that were not presented, because they have personally told me.

Finally the media's suggestion that screaming coming from my home can help release the emotional injuries from my "follower's" childhoods are completely erroneous. It is impossible for any person to experience or release the emotions of any other person. I teach personal responsibility for everything we do. If Mary or I are angry, frightened, sad or feeling ashamed, then these are our own emotions, and only we can release them by experiencing them.

Accusations about causing a rift between Kym Valentine and Fabio Tolli

In the third presentation, Channel 9 focused on a "rift" that had been created between a Kym Valentine, an actor who used to be in Neighbours, and Fabio Tolli, a musician who listens to my seminars:

"We begin with the latest development in our investigation into the Aussie Jesus cult, and we can tell you that Kym Valentine, the Neighbours soapy star, has been caught up in the bizarre movement."

And later on:

"He's involvement in a sect which claims Jesus Christ himself was it's leader, which has pushed the relationship between the soapy star and her ex to it's lowest point. A movement led by this man, Alan John Miller."

Since the pair were already divorced before I met Fabio, Channel 9 are purposely distorting the truth to make it appear that I am responsible for any breakdown in their relationship, when their relationship had already ended in divorce before they met me. In addition, at the time of the presentation, I had only personally met Fabio on three occasions, and did not know him well at all. I had not ever spent any personal time with him or his family. I have only during the last year (2012) come to know him much better.

At the time of the Channel 9 report, I had no knowledge of any interactions between Fabio and his ex-wife. I was only aware that he had a child from an ex-marriage, and I had seen his child at one of the seminars. I fail to see how my interactions with Fabio in public at three seminars presented in Melbourne (all of which are on YouTube), can do what Channel 9 claimed. Over a period of one and a half years, I had only seen Fabio 3 times, and had no opportunity to talk to him privately.

I believe that when people practice my teachings their relationships with others become more real (in that each person will be much more honest with each other than before), and therefore more loving. Of course, this sometimes results in friction, because people are not used to hearing the full truth from each other. Many people, once hearing the teachings, confess things that they have done to their partners or families that the family was unaware of. This will, of course, mean that the family will face some emotions to feel as a result of them now knowing the truth. My teachings encourage others to only be truthful with each other in a loving manner. This means you would be loving to yourself as well as the other person, and it will not be what the world defines as love.

"On screen her life featured a series of twists and turns.

(Clip form "The Wright Stuff") Reporter: Ramsay Street's teacher Libby Kennedy, who's been put through the mill these past 15 years...

In fact in private, Kym's life was imitating her art.

(Clip form "The Wright Stuff") Reporter: Is your real life half as much fun?

Kym: Oh far worse! (Laughs) Far worse. Yeah."

I have had no dealings with Kym Valentine, and yet through editing and inference Channel 9 are attempting to link my teachings about how people can grow in Love and Truth with Kym's tumultuous life (on-screen amazingly), which I have had nothing to do with. In the whole of this third presentation they are attempting to create a story out of nothing, and this demonstrates of how shallow the media is, as they will attempt to create a story with what is just a tenuous link between myself, through Fabio Tolli, now a friend of mine who comes to my seminars, and a TV actor whom he was once married to, merely because she has some level of public fame.

"The doomsday prophecies like these have driven a wedge between the soapy star and her ex-husband. The Neighbour's bombshell's believed to be concerned about any influence the Divine Truth may have on her seven year old daughter."

As I have explained above, since I am not making any doomsday prophecies it is impossible for me to have driven a wedge between Kym Valentine and her ex-husband through those prophecies, because I have not made them. I do not believe myself in the condition to make accurate prophecies about the future, and I have stated this publicly many times. Anybody who states I am making firm prophecies about the future has not listened to my many comments about my own personal condition and abilities.

Accusations from a woman who used to listen to my teachings

In the second presentation:

"Jessica Solkowski was introduced to the Divine Truth and AJ Miller at the age of 12.

As I previously said, I met Jessica Solkowski in Western Australia at the home of a friend of mine, John Kreppold who has since passed. She was visiting John with her mother. I made no attempt to introduce her to the teachings of Divine Truth. Her mother asked me questions in a private setting which I subsequently answered. When my friend died, I stayed with Jessica and her mother in a spare bedroom during the time of his death and funeral, so I got to know the family well during that time.

The media are suggesting that I am recruiting children, which is a thinly veiled implication that I am somehow grooming them for my "cult". This is a complete lie. Some of the people who come to my seminars have children, and so sometimes they bring their children along with them. However I have no control over the children, just as I have no control over their parents. They are free to come and go from my seminars, or listen to any of my material, in any manner that they wish to.

Jessica: I didn't know that it was like as bizarre as it actually is now looking back. I began to think that I was being able to speak to spirits and that."

Many people who come to my seminars find that they have abilities to communicate with spirits after they work through some of their emotional injuries, while many others come to the realisation that they have been communicating with spirits for a long time, but were not previously consciously aware of the fact. I discuss this in the talk "20090208 Spirit Relationships – Law of Rapport and Spirit Communication". Since Western medicine labels any kind of spirit communication as some form of psychiatric disorder, and because there is a large amount of fear and judgment about that in modern society, this often can create fear in people that they are imagining the spirit communication that they are having, and therefore might have some form of mental illness

A way that we often use to avoid confronting these fears that are within us is to label them as "bizarre", because we are not wanting to come to terms with the truth as that would involve us needing to experience our fears on the certain subject. From my personal interactions with Jessica, I believe that she was speaking with spirits. This began when I was not present, since I was overseas at the time. This stopped when her father became progressively violent towards her mother about the subject, and began personally threatening my life as well. Jessica became very afraid of his potential actions, and then shut down her ability to communicate with spirits. From that time she also refused to talk to me if I visited their home.

"And so I received what I thought were messages about certain events that were going to happen."

Many people on Earth are currently receiving messages from spirits who wish us to prepare for the potential changes that happen to the Earth, as I have mentioned above. One way to avoid our fears about these events is dismiss the messages we receive about them. I encourage everybody to confront and experience every fear inside of them, since each fear is blocking our relationship with God.

And in the third presentation:

"Jessica: And my family started pulling away from me. One of my closest aunties didn't want anything to do with me and it just absolutely broke me."

The media are suggesting that I am responsible for Ms. Solkowski's problems with her family. I encourage people to treat everyone lovingly, including their families. I am aware of a lot of threats of violence which occurred in this family towards Jessica's mother, and I understand how this would have influenced Jessica to reverse her own analysis of her own personal experiences which occurred when I was not present. This behaviour would naturally cause a child to become afraid, and so I completely understand why Jessica must now say many things that I personally do not believe she feels. She is doing this only to gain the approval of potentially violent family members.

"Jessica Solkowski learned the Divine Truth teachings for a year and half and has this advice for its followers.

Jessica: It just doesn't make sense what he's teaching. And especially if you have kids, don't get them involved. Let them make their own decision as they grow older."

Again Ms. Solkowski is suggesting that I have lured her or others into hearing my teachings, when as I have said I have no control over who listens to my teachings. I did not personally lure Jessica into believing anything, and I supported her attempts to ask questions. In addition, everything I teach is about letting people, including children, make their own decisions. I do not believe that Jessica was allowed to make her own decisions since I personally received many death threats from her father in a rage, making assumptions about Jessica that were never true. This rage was also expressed towards Jessica's mother. I feel it is understandable that a child would be afraid of this amount of rage projected at someone she loves, which would cause her to change her mind about her own experiences in order to placate the rage.

One of the reasons that I have equal numbers of men and women in my audiences is because while the emotional aspect of my teachings are appealing to women, the logical nature of the Divine Truth is very appealing to men. So to say that the Divine Truth does not make sense demonstrates a lack of understanding of my teachings by Ms. Solkowski, rather than a flaw in the Divine Truth. There are a large number of persons who disagree with her about the logic present in my teachings.

Conclusion

Overall, I found the Channel 9 presentation has a little more truth in it than the Channel 7 presentations, which were almost entirely fictitious. But, both Channel 9 and Channel 7 seem to have a strong desire to create sensation rather than actually report the facts. In addition, like almost all media I have come in contact with, there is little desire to actually present truthful information or to listen to anything that may disagree with their pre-formed opinion. Both channels do not live up to the "Code of Practice" they declare to support. As I pointed out to Channel 9, the "Code of Practice" is not a legal document either, and in my personal experience I have not found the media industry to be very good at self-regulation when it comes to reporting the truth.

These presentations by Channel 9 are another attempt by the media to create a sensational story out of a large body of lies and fabrication, or to distort the truth through innuendo and suggestion. Channel 9 spent around 15 minutes of time with Mary and me personally. They were present at one Albury seminar in 2011, and had a short interview with me afterward. The rest of

the so-called information about us came from our own YouTube videos or through comments from third parties.

They are taking what they know has created media interest in the past, and also what they know are lies about my personal circumstances; including such references to doomsday cults, and are creating stories that are fictitious to manipulate the public into experiencing fears about me and my teachings. They are using these lies and manipulations as tools in an attempt to create a story that bears no relation to the actual truth, for the purpose of getting higher ratings and making money.

As a result of my dealings with the media, I now place a full, unedited copy of every interview I that I give on the Divine Truth website and on the Divine Truth Channel on YouTube, since I have learnt from my previous experiences, including with Channel 9 during the preparation of this program, that the media twist the truth in order to sensationalize their presentation.

Unfortunately, I did not record the interview with Channel 9. Most people who were present during the interview found the interview to be simple and direct, and felt that if the entire interview was played to the public, very few members of the public would have felt any concerns. Instead of doing this, Channel 9 presented many clips of what I say out of context and edited my responses so that people cannot hear the full answers to questions that I was asked, which is highly misleading, and designed to manipulate the public into buying the story that the media wish to create, rather than actually delivering the truth.

After the Channel 9 reports were aired, we received much fewer negative responses from members of the public than after the Channel 7 "Today Tonight" shows were aired. Channel 7 actually requested that I do not talk to Channel 9 until they aired their own program, and I could not agree to this. Then Channel 7 decided to make a hastily prepared program, which left them open to legal action, since most of their claims were completely false and defamatory, and could be shown to be so from our own recordings of our interactions.

Any person who is open to discovering the Truth will need to question the underlying motives that the media seems to have to distort the truth or present actual lies in order to maintain their power base. This seems to be a general problem in the media. I am personally looking forward to meeting a media professional who does not do this, since I believe now that such a person will be a rare find indeed.

At the moment, many members of the media and public are accusing me of the same things I was accused of in the first century, with the only difference being that they are using a different physical medium. This demonstrates how little things have really changed in 2000 years of human history. Hopefully change will begin to happen soon, when the general public firstly realizes they are being manipulated daily by the media, and secondly desires that to change because the public is ready to face the truth.
