Response

The report given in the article accompanying the Channel 7 "Sunday Night" TV programme is almost entirely false in its claims about Mary and I.

The reporters, David Millikan and his cameraman, came to stay at our home for two nights free of charge, during which time we cooked and cleaned for them, gave them unrestricted access to our property, and demonstrated complete openness and honesty in dealing with them. We also had them visit us again on a number of occasions, and some of our friends allowed Mr Millikan and the Channel 7 crew to visit their property while we were staying with there in NSW. We

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stated that we would not take legal action against Channel 7 if they purposefully lied about us and misrepresented us, a promise that Mr Millikan has taken full advantage of. We stated this because we believe that it is loving for us to give a gift of ourselves, our time and our sincerity without concern about whether others misuse the gift. How people respond to gifts is a measure of their own development in love.

The way that Channel 7 responded to the gift of our time and our hospitality has been to fabricate a series of lies about us in order to create a media "sensation", to improve their ratings and to make money. They are fully aware of the lies that they are telling but have chosen to act without integrity for the reasons stated above. I will address each of the points that were raised in the TV presentation and explain the falsifications that were contained within the program featured.

Response to the Internet article

"Cult experts have warned that a 47-year-old Queensland man and self-proclaimed "Jesus" is in the early stages of developing a dangerous religious sect comparable to WACO, which ended in mass-suicide."

While I do claim that I am Jesus, and I do live in Queensland, I am not in any stage of developing a religious sect or cult. I have no intention of developing a new religion, because I believe there are already too many religions on the planet that are fighting with one another. I also have no intention of developing a cult, since I do not wish to control anyone in their day to day life, nor do I wish to control how people respond to what I teach.

The only people who have ever compared me to WACO are members of the media themselves. Nobody who knows me has ever made such a comparison. I do not believe any person on earth should have a firearm, or use any other implement as a weapon. I do not believe that suicide is a viable option for any person, and I actively discourage people from committing suicide, since I can see the results in the spirit world for them after they have committed suicide, which are often not very pleasant. There is no cult or religious sect, and using this terminology is an attempt by the media to sensationalize.

I do not wish to have any control over the lives of people who listen to my teachings. I desire to teach them how to develop a direct and close relationship with God and how to grow in love, without any intermediary, including myself. In fact I actively discourage people from focusing on me rather than their relationship with God, and regularly advise people to connect to God rather than attempting to connect to myself.

An example of these teachings can be found in the talk "20100412 The Human Soul - Taking Personal Responsibility", where I describe how important it is for people to take full responsibility for every aspect of their lives, including the decisions they make with their lives and their own spiritual progression.

I also teach that from God's perspective that if you try to control somebody else then you are out of harmony with the Law of Free Will, and this will damage our souls and lead to negative consequences in our lives. Since my primary aim in life is to grow in love and grow towards God, this is a direct contradiction of my teachings and how I live my life. These teachings are described in the talk "20120421 The Human Soul - The Gift of Free Will" and "20120422 The Human Soul - The Gift of Free Will".

"Former real estate developer, Alan John Miller..."

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My primary profession before I became a teacher of the Divine Truth was actually a computer engineer, although I did have also run companies involved in property development.

"... from Kingaroy in Queensland."

I live 36kms outside of Kingaroy, in a 2 bedroom house situated on 40 acres of land with Mary.

"... is the leader of Gods Way of Love"

Myself and Mary have established the God's Way of Love Organization with the objective of teaching Divine Truth, Divine Love, God's Laws and Humility in action in every practical aspect of life. The objectives and principles of this organization are available for anybody to read if they wish, and can be found in the constitution on the God's Way of Love website [here](http://www.godswayoflove.org/) (<http://www.godswayoflove.org/>). I have yet to upload the latest version of the constitution. The media is attempting to portray us as some kind of secret organization, or "cult", when in fact all of our objectives and teachings are open and freely available for everybody on the Internet.

"He has an estimated 100,000 DVDs in global circulation and financially survives on collecting donations from followers."

All of my presentations, and all of the DVDs that we distribute, are provided for free. While there is a donation box at the back of the room when I give seminars, there is no obligation for people to donate, and there is no collection. Mary and I do live off the donations kindly given by people, but we will also return donations to people if we feel that they are not given in the spirit of love or if there is any kind of requirement of us in return, since this is not a true gift. Nor do we accept donations from people who are short of money themselves.

"He also uses donations to acquire property for sanctuaries - in preparation for doomsday."

This is a complete lie. The only property I own is my two bedroom home where I live with Mary. I purchased this property with my own funds from my business and property development days before I met Mary. Mary and I own no other property, nor do we purchase property with funds donated to us. We have better things to do with the donations than purchase more property, and the donations are not significant enough in size to enable us to purchase any property anyway.

There are several properties that are located around the world, in Australia and Sweden currently, that other people personally own and manage, that Mary and myself visit occasionally at the request of the owners of those properties. The owners wish to bring their properties into more harmony with what I teach, and so they ask us for our advice about the running of these properties. These people do not donate the property to the God's Way Of Love organization, nor to myself or Mary. They continue to own the property and manage it how they see fit. However, they have requested that the God's Way of Love Organisation, and Mary and I specifically, give them personal advice. They wish to use their properties with the objective that they are used as a place to demonstrate the principles of God's Love in practice. Mary and I do not own the properties, but rather we advise practices that can be done on those properties to improve and restore the ecosystems in a way that is harmonious with Divine Truth. I have described this in the talk "20111008 God's Way of Love – Constitution Changes". The owners of these properties can stop following our teachings at any time without any penalty of any kind. They have and retain complete ownership and control over their own properties.

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I have never stated anywhere that the properties have been donated for use to the God's Way of Love Organisation, or that they are any form of preparation for a "doomsday". The actual owners of these properties see them as long term projects used to teach any person who desires how to bring a property into more harmony with the principles of love. These media comments are an attempt by the media to sensationalise the report in order to gain attraction and ratings, but at the same time the claims are completely false. I do not believe or teach that there will be any doomsday. I do currently feel that events will take place on the Earth that could be severe in terms of geographical changes. However I do not believe that this is the end of the world or the end of human civilisation or life.

"The earth will "change a lot" in the next few years, Miller believes. "What you now know as countries will disappear completely, other ones will change completely," he told his followers at a recent seminar aired by Sunday Night."

The seminar that I gave at which the Sunday Night crew were present at was "20110319 The Human Soul – Addictions and Bribery, Fear, Threats and Blackmail". In this seminar I did not talk about potential changes that will happen on Earth in the future. I talked about how people can develop their souls and grow in love by identifying the addictions that they have in their lives. Channel 7 are well aware of this as they were present at the talk.

However, as I above have stated, I do believe that the earth will change a lot over the coming few years, and at this point in time I still believe that some countries may completely disappear and others will change completely. I believe these changes happen cyclically to the earth, and there is physical evidence for these changes occurring in the past. I do not believe there will be a doomsday, or that these events are a part of the Biblical Armageddon.

I have spent very little time in my seminars talking about Earth changes – out of approximately 700 hours of presentations that are currently on YouTube, I have probably only spoken about Earth changes for a total of about 5 or 6 hours.

My teachings focus on encouraging people to release their fears by experiencing them, since our fears prevent us from forming a close relationship with God. So I encourage people to focus on all of their fears, such as fears about what other people think of them, or fears about speaking the truth, as well as external fears such as fears of what changes might happen to the Earth in the future. The media have taken a clip of a presentation where I was encouraging people to focus on their fears about Earth changes and have presented it out of context in order to manipulate the public into thinking that I have formed some kind doomsday cult, so that they can liken me to people in the past who actually have formed doomsday cults. The talk where I did encourage people to focus on their fears about Earth changes can be viewed in full on YouTube and is the talk "20091024 The Human Soul – Fear Revisited".

"Cult expert Rick Ross told Sunday Night that Miller is still a fairly new leader who hasn't fully developed his group. "It is still in its early stages but the idea that the group is coming together in a community and that Miller is developing a compound in my opinion is ominous," he said. "Only the most extreme cults isolate themselves in a compound, such as Jonestown or WACO Davidians group, which both ended tragically in mass suicides."

Rick Ross may be an expert about cults; I do not know, because I have never met him. He is certainly not an expert about me or about what I teach, since almost every reference he makes about me is completely incorrect. He makes assumptions about me, based from what I can see, on his own previous experiences with other people.

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I have been teaching Divine Truth for eight years now to groups all over the world. I am not in the process of developing any group or cult. I present my teachings in the form of a seminar to people who have invited me to speak, and then I move on. I have little to do with the people who come to the seminars in my own day to day life, not because I do not wish to know them better, but rather because I just want to keep on doing what I enjoy; which is presenting the Divine Truth for free to as many people who wish to listen. Some people who have known me for a few years have moved to live in the region where I live, but I did not personally encourage or ask any of them to do so, and I have not personally visited many of them in their own homes mostly because I do not have time to do so when Mary and I are home. These people have purchased their own properties near me without ever discussing their intentions or reasons for doing so beforehand.

As Channel 7 are well aware, since they have stayed at my home, I am not developing a compound, and do not have a compound. Nobody else lives with us although occasionally we do have visitors to our home. As Channel 7 know, since they stayed with us, we don't even have fences around our property. We took them all down as some wildlife were getting caught in them. Our property is just our private home. Channel 7's desire to call it a compound is an attempt to manipulate the public by creating a link between my personal life, and the personal life of destructive cult leaders around the world, when no such link actually exists.

Furthermore the people who choose to listen to my teachings are not isolating themselves from society. The large majority of the people interested in the teachings of Divine Truth do not live near to us. The ones that we know are scattered around the world, and are fully involved and productive members of their societies. All of the seminars and presentations are open to the public and people can come free of charge, or they can watch them in full on YouTube. There is no secrecy about any of the presentations, which the media are implying to sensationalise their story. Since the presentations, in their unedited form, are also freely available to anyone in the world, there is no system of monitoring who listens, who does not, and how people choose to interpret the teachings. Neither Mary nor I wish to have any of these kinds of control over these things. Just because I am saying I am Jesus does not mean that I am doing the same things that others, who have claimed to be me, are currently doing or have done in the past.

Part of the Divine Truth I teach also strongly discourages people from ever committing suicide, since our lives continue in the spirit world and we reap serious consequences for what is essentially murdering ourselves. I talk about this in the talk "20100815 Spirit Life – What Happens when you die Introduction Part 1" and "20100822 Spirit Life – What happens when you die Introduction Part 2".

"This is when groups become extreme because the leader controls everything," he said."

As I have outlined above, I have no desire to control anybody who comes to listen to my talks, and so I do not implement any control over them. This is in direct contradiction to the Divine Truth teachings and the way in which I live my life. Channel 7 are also aware of this because they interviewed a number of people who come to my presentations, all of whom did not say that I control them (Channel 7 chose to not believe them). Many of the people who come to my presentations are very well educated and are very able to tell whether or not they are being controlled, but instead the media portray them as ignorant victims in an attempt add weight to their false claims.

"He is surrounded by people who have walked out of marriages and businesses. They have forsaken all to follow Jesus," Millikan said."

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Most people who listen to my teachings are still in the same relationships that they were in when they met me. There are some people who listen to my teachings who have left their relationships, but they have done so on their own accord, not due to any direct consultation that I have had with them. I do not teach people to leave their marriages, but I do help people to examine within themselves what is going on emotionally for themselves within relationships. So on some occasions this causes people to re-evaluate whether they would like to stay in the marriage that they are in, and to examine whether their marriage is still based on love. In fact I often encourage people to stay in their relationships because it is not moral to leave a marriage just because of different spiritual belief systems. I described this in the talk "20120513 The Human Soul – Ethics and Morality".

I also do not encourage people to walk out of their businesses. I encourage people to follow their desires, and to not continue to work in a job that they do not like. Many people, when they start listening the these aspects of Divine Truth, come to have an awareness that they are not enjoying the jobs that they are currently doing, and so they decide that they do not want to do those jobs any more, and instead they find a job they love. This is not a result of a direct communication with me; it is a result of self discovery that they have reached themselves as a result of connecting to what their true desires are.

This statement is another attempt by Channel 7 to manipulate the public into thinking that I am attempting to break down the fabric of modern society by ruining marriages and businesses. What I am doing is encouraging people to discover for themselves what they want to do with their lives, rather than living their lives according to what they feel they ought to do. I have no personal investment as to whether people choose to stay in their marriages or jobs or not.

"Neuroscientist Dr Louise Faber left the Queensland Brain Institute to buy a property next to Miller in O'Dea Road, outside Kingaroy. I asked her if she believed Miller was Jesus. She said: "Oh yes, David, I know he is Jesus"."

While she does live near me, Louise Faber has not bought a property next to mine. This is another falsification by the media to imply that I am controlling people who listen to the Divine Truth by having them close to me, when that is not the case. In fact, in the nearly two years of her living in the area, I have only visited her home once, and that was last week, in September 2012.

The quote given is also a complete fabrication. Louise Faber says she never spoke to David Millikan about the question of my identity. What's more when David Millikan visited and interviewed us in March 2011, she was uncertain of my identity, and therefore even if that question had been asked of her she would not have replied in that manner.

"Ross said: "Basically Miller sets himself up as God, he is Jesus Christ, he is a God man and if you disagree with him you disagree with God so if you have a spouse or a family member and they are critical of Miller they have come against God and therefore they are not spiritually right for you.""

Channel 7 and David Millikan are well aware that I do not set myself up as God. The media are making the accusation that because I say that I am Jesus then I am saying that I am God, but this is based on falsities that are taught by the Bible, and on David Millikan's own false beliefs that Jesus is God. During our private conversations this was his main issue with me. I am a son of God, just as every human on Earth is a son or daughter of God. I am not part of God, although in the first century I did become Divine in nature, in that I was in a condition of love that I became at-one with God. I see myself as a brother and equal to all other humans on

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Earth and in the spirit world. Every person who has ever lived had the opportunity to become at-one with God.

I do not require people to agree with me, and in fact I am surrounded by many people do not agree with me on many subjects. It is clear from any of the presentations that I have given that I am open to being questioned and disagreed with regularly. I do not suggest that if people disagree with me that they are going "against God" or that they will be punished by God in any way, which is what the media statement is stating. However, if people treat me in an unkind manner, and continue to do so in my presentations, then I ask them to leave.

I do not believe God punishes anyone, and God is not a wrathful being as most of the world's religions claim. The representatives of Channel 7 personally know that I am not making a claim to be God. This is another attempt by the media to portray me as controlling and manipulative, when they themselves are attempting to manipulate and control the public through their lies and deceit.

I find it interesting, though, that Channel 7 has almost word for word replicated many of the criticisms that were leveled towards me during my life in the 1st century. At times, I do find this quite amusing really, that nothing has really changed in peoples attitude towards me, and that even a so-called Christian minister, David Millikan, can almost repeat word for word the accusations from the 1st century, while fully knowing himself that these accusations are wrong, without actually considering the unethical nature of his own actions, nor that his own "Jesus" was accused of exactly the same things.

As described above, I do not teach or encourage people to leave relationships due to differences in spiritual beliefs, since this would be an immoral act.

"Mr Miller seems to use his position as Jesus to get sexual favours from women that he is attracted to...it reminds me of many so called cult leaders that I have run into over the years who use their position of spiritual authority to get what they want sexually, financially, in whatever means they wish from people that become their followers," he said."

I have personally met some of these men who are like Rick Ross describes, so I do know that such men exist. I have met men in spiritual circles who only attend some spiritual circles in order to develop sexual relationships with women. So I do agree with Rick Ross than many so-called spiritual men and women use their position for sexual favors. I have discussed such people in the talk "20120226 Spirit Relationships - Spirit Influence S2 (Of Other Spirits)" especially in the second part of that talk.

When Mr Ross compares me with such men, he is just going by his own experience with other men. This claim by the media is just an attempt to put down my character, and turn me into a sexual deviant. I find it quite amusing because, in my personal life, I have and still am often condemned as a sexual prude. In fact, I have had many people get up and leave during my talks when I talk about sexual morality, and they have complained to me that my moral stance on sexual behavior is prudish and unacceptable to them.

I have an entirely monogamous relationship with Mary, and have not been involved sexually with any other woman who listens currently or who has listened to my teachings in the past. I have no desire to engage sexually with any woman apart from Mary. And aside from that this claim is in direct conflict with moral teachings that I give about sexuality, which I have described in the talks "20120513 The Human Soul – Ethics and Morality" and "20110625 The Human Soul – Sexual Attraction".

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Further to that, and as outlined above, I do not use any position of spiritual authority to make gains financially, as firstly I do not set myself up as an authority over other people, and secondly I give all of my presentations and material away for free.

"Miller told Sunday Night his first memories of his past life as Jesus occurred when he was two, having nails driven through his feet. "I didn't put them together as I'm Jesus from that. I just slotted it in to the back of my head and merely got on with my life until... I started having a lot more specific memories about my life... at 33." He claimed his teachings "are all about love and developing relationships" and denied being cult leader. "I don't see how I can be a cult leader when I ask everybody to actually engage their own desires," he said. Meanwhile, Miller told reporter Millikan that he performed most miracles, as they are in the Bible, but he disputed others. "Most of the miracles involving recovery of people's sight [and] the recovery of their limbs but the walking on water is one of the things that I didn't do. "Another one that I didn't do was turn the water into wine.""

This is the only part of the entire article that does relay some of the things that I said, although it is heavily edited and taken out of context. It is placed at the end of the article, after a large number of defamatory and false claims, so that public will be inclined to completely disregard the words. This is another attempt by the media to manipulate and control the story and the public's response to the story.

I explained to Mr Millikan in detail why I did not perform so-called miracles in the 1st century until I was around 31 years of age. In addition, I explained the process of becoming at-one with God, and that the performance of all miracles after 31 years of age in the 1st century was the result of God choosing to act through me. I had to firstly reach the condition were miracles could be performed; and this is why there is no record of my performing miracles before the time I have specified. Many of the "miracles" that the Bible says I performed I did not perform, and these events were created from the imaginations of the Bible revisionists in order to compare me with other so-called legendary people who also did not perform the miracles attributed to them.

In addition, I do not believe that I am personally capable of performing miracles without having a connection to God. I also explained the process of becoming at-one with God, and how I say to people that they do not need me to have a personal relationship with God.

Conclusion

This article and accompanying TV programme is another attempt by Channel 7 to create a sensational story out of a large body of lies and fabrication. They are taking what they know has created media interest in the past, and also what they know are lies about my personal circumstances; including such references to doomsday cults, and are creating stories that are fictitious to manipulate the public into experiencing fears about me and my teachings. They are using these lies and manipulations as tools in an attempt to create a story that bears no relation to the actual truth, for the purpose of getting higher ratings and making money.

After this report was aired, we were attacked by many people who believed that the media would not lie. When we replied to these people that most of the information was untrue, most people refused to believe that the media could be so willing to lie directly without something being done about it. As a result, many people still believe these untruths, and we believe that

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this was the underlying motive of Mr Millikan; to ensure that people would not listen to anything we teach by lying about what we teach.

Any person who is open to discovering the Truth will need to question the underlying motives that the media seems to have to distort the truth or present actual lies in order to maintain their power base. This seems to be a general problem in the media. I am personally looking forward to meeting a media professional who does not do this, since I believe now that such a person will be a rare find indeed.

At the moment, many members of the media and public are accusing me of the same things I was accused of in the first century, with the only difference being that they are using a different physical medium. This demonstrates how little things have really changed in 2000 years of human history. Hopefully change will begin to happen soon, when the general public realize they are being manipulated daily by the media, and desire that to change because the public is ready to face the truth.
